WV DEP ANNOUNCES ABANDONED MINE LANDS AND RECLAMATION FUNDING

The West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection announced Dec. 20 six economic and community development projects throughout the state that will share in \$30 million from the WVDEP's Office of Abandoned Mine Lands and Reclamation.

The pilot project funding was authorized by Congress last December under the Consolidated Appropriations Act, according to a WVDEP news release. U.S. Treasury funds will supply a total of \$90 to be split among West Virginia, Pennsylvania and Kentucky with the goal of speeding up the remediation of Abandoned Mine Lands sites that have the potential to improve the local economy. The projects were approved by the federal Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement, the DEP served only as a facilitator for the application process.

The six projects in West Virginia are:

- Patriot Gardens Golden Delicious Apple Project, which involves the West Virginia National Guard, working to plant 100,000 apple trees on 500 acres in Nicholas and Clay counties;
