## **TAKE ACTION TO STOP THE PROPOSED RULE REDEFINING "WATERS OF THE U.S."**

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers (Corps) are close to finalizing their proposed rule redefining "waters of the U.S." and making many more areas subject to federal control. More federal control would require nearly all construction sites to obtain often unnecessary Clean Water Act permits. The vast majority of new areas covered by these rules are currently protected by state and local governments so any increase to overall water quality are questionable. Later today, the House is expected to vote on H.R. 1732, the Regulatory Integrity Protection Act. This legislation would send the federal rule back to the drawing board and force the agencies to develop a new rule in consultation with state and local governments and affected groups to ensure that the new rule is based on better science and realistic economic analysis. Members attending the CAWV Congressional Fly-In encouraged West Virginia's delegation to support the bill since nearly all types of construction in West Virginia is effected by the rule. ## **GOVERNOR TOMBLIN APPOINTS STEVEN SHAFFER TO 52<sup>ND</sup> DISTRICT IN HOUSE**

Gov. Earl Ray Tomblin recently announced the appointment of Steven Shaffer to represent the citizens of the 52nd District in the West Virginia House of Delegates. Shaffer's appointment fills the vacancy created by the resignation of Larry Williams. Shaffer's appointment is effective immediately. The former coal miner is a longtime resident of Preston County and was elected as the mayor of Tunnelton in 1980. He was later elected to the Preston County Board of Education in 1996, serving a total of four years. Shaffer served as the assistant prosecutor for Preston County from 2003 to 2005, and currently is a partner at Estep & Shaffer, L.C. Attorneys at Law.

## **JOINT SELECT COMMITTEE ON TAX REFORM TO MEET MONDAY, MAY 4**

The Joint Select Committee on Tax Reform is set to meet on Monday, May 4. Last month, state lawmakers announced the formation of a special joint committee with the intentions to tackle comprehensive tax reform. The committee, of which House of Delegates Speaker Tim Armstead, R-Kanawha, and Senate President Bill Cole, R-Mercer, will serve as non-voting members, will focus on developing and proposing legislation which will create a fair and simple tax structure that will promote economic growth in West Virginia. Sen. Mike Hall, R-Putnam, will serve as co-chairman of the committee along with Del. Eric Nelson, R-Kanawha, Senate and House Finance Committee chairs, respectively. They will be working with a number of local and national entities to see if West Virginia's tax code makes the state competitive and predictable when stacked up against other states. He said committee members will not be rushed into making decisions without proper study. It's been 2008 since the tax code was last reviewed. Legislative leaders have indicated highway fund taxes may become part of the committee's study. The committee is set to meet again on Monday, May 18, 2015.

## **AGC WEIGHS IN HOURS OF SERVICE**

This week, the House Transportation & Infrastructure Subcommittee on Highways and Transit held a hearing that looked at the role of federal regulations as it pertains to Commercial Motor Vehicle Safety, including Hours of Service regulations. AGC of America submitted a statement outlining its transportation reauthorization priorities on issues affecting the construction industry under the jurisdiction of the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration. These priorities include expanding the current construction industry exemption from Federal Hours of Service Regulations (HOS), extending the HOS exemption for construction transportation in emergency circumstances, expanding the construction industry exclusion to eliminate the 30-minute rest period requirement, deferring the implementation of the new restart provisions in the new truck driver HOS regulations that became effective July 1, 2013, and applying a construction exemption to the requirement that all motor carriers who maintain Record of Duty status for HOS recordkeeping use electronic logging devices. AGC will continue to push for the inclusion of these priorities as Congress works on completing a surface transportation reauthorization bill.

## **REP. MCKINLEY ENERGY EFFICIENCY PLAN SINGED INTO LAW**

The Energy Efficiency Improvement Act, introduced by West Virginia Congressman David B. McKinley, P.E., has been officially signed by the White House. President Obama signed the bipartisan legislation, introduced by Reps. McKinley and Welch (D-VT), to encourage voluntary improvements in efficiency. ## **FALL PROTECTION CLEARANCE DISTANCE**

Personal Fall Arrest Systems (PFAS) must be used in accordance with the following OSHA requirements:

*OSHA Construction Standard 1926.501 (b)(1) "Each employee on a walking/working surface (horizontal and vertical surface) with an unprotected side or edge which is 6 feet (1.8 m) or more above a lower level shall be protected from falling by the use of guardrail systems, safety net systems, or personal fall arrest systems."*

*OSHA Construction Standard 1926.502 (d)(16) "Personal fall arrest systems, when stopping a fall, shall: limit maximum arresting force on an employee to 1,800 pounds when used with a body harness; be rigged such that an employee can neither free fall more than 6 feet, nor contact any lower level; bring an employee to a complete stop and limit maximum deceleration distance an employee travels to 3.5 feet; and, have sufficient strength to withstand twice the potential impact energy of an employee free falling a distance of 6 feet, or the free fall distance permitted by the system, whichever is less."*

It is important that employees be trained in the hazards associated with working at heights of 6 feet or more with unprotected sides and in calculating PFAS clearance distance and that this training is documented. In the event of a fall it is important to ensure that the worker will not free fall more than 6 feet. Free falling more than 6 feet has broken workers necks from impact force. If workers contact lower levels the PFAS is useless. Use a deceleration device to ensure forces do not exceed 1,800 pounds. Use a chart when calculating PFAS clearance distance which can be found online or from the PFAS manufacturer.

## HOUSE SUBCOMMITTEE MOVES TRANSPORTATION FUNDING BILL

The House Appropriations Subcommittee on Transportation, Housing and Urban Development (THUD) passed their fiscal year 2016 funding bill. The bill includes funding for the Department of Transportation, the Department of Housing and Urban Development, and other related agencies. Total spending in the bill is \$55.3 billion – an increase of \$1.5 billion above fiscal year 2015 and \$9.7 billion below the president’s budget request. It should be noted that the president’s request is significantly higher due to his proposal to levy a 14 percent tax on every U.S. corporation’s past foreign earnings (deemed repatriation). The bill provides \$40.25 billion from the Highway Trust Fund for the Federal-aid Highway Program and \$10.7 billion for the Federal Transit Administration, including \$8.6 billion for formula grants and \$1.9 billion for Capital Investments Grants, known as “New Starts.” Additionally, the legislation funds TIGER grants at \$100 million – \$400 million below fiscal year 2015 and \$1.15 billion below the president’s request. The bill is expected to be considered by the full Appropriations Committee the week of May 16.

## MOTOR FUEL TAX REVENUES LESS IN APRIL; OTHER DOH REVENUES STRONGER

Motor Fuel Tax collections in April 2015 are \$33.7 million, which is 3.5 percent down from the Governor’s Estimate for the month of \$34.9 million. April 2015 Motor Fuel collections are also down \$10.6 million from April 2014 figures, or 2.85 percent. Registration fees at \$10.9 million

are up 43 percent from the Governor's Estimate of \$7.6 million. Privilege Tax revenues in April are above the Governor's Estimate -- \$19.5 million collected verses \$16 million estimated. Total revenue collected in April was \$64.1 million versus the Governor's Estimate of \$58.6 million, or 9.4 percent above estimates.

Total collections through ten months of FY 2015 are \$606.5 million, or \$32.7 million above the Governor's Estimate of \$573.7 million. The \$606.5 million collection for 2015 is about \$2 million than actual collections last year. Actual collections for FY 2014 were \$604.4 million compared to \$606 million so far this year.

This is probably the first month that actual FY 2015 revenues have exceeded the same period last year. Even though Motor Fuel collections are down \$10.6 million for the first ten months, Registration fees and Privilege Tax revenues are about \$13 million ahead of last year's collections.
