## **SENATOR JOE MANCHIN FOCUSSES ON INFRASTRUCTURE WEEK**

This week was national “Infrastructure Week”. Business, labor, policy, and thought leaders assembled in Washington, DC and around the country to convey the importance of infrastructure in the economy, highlight how infrastructure impacts American lives and discuss innovative, long-term solutions to address the nation’s growing infrastructure needs. When it comes to infrastructure, not only are our roads, bridges, railways, ports, water pipelines, and airports in need of repair, so too is our approach to solving these problems, these leaders have noted.

Sen. Joe Manchin, D-WV along with seven colleagues, all former governors, worked together this week to encourage members of Congress to pass infrastructure legislation. Manchin’s colleagues included Sens. Jeanne Shaheen, D-N.H.; Angus King, I-Maine; Michael Rounds, R-S.D.; Tim Kaine, D-Va.; John Hoeven, R-N.D.; Mark Warner, D-Va.; and Tom Carper, D-Del. The senators highlighted Infrastructure Week in a letter to Congress, saying it reminds American’s “we must move beyond the short-term fixes that have come to characterize recent infrastructure debates and rather work together to find comprehensive solutions...” The eight senators noted in their letter that economists have estimated that increasing infrastructure funding by only 1 percent of the Gross Domestic Product (GDP) would result in an increase in economic output by \$270 billion over a three-year period and add 730,000 jobs to the nation’s workforce in 2015 alone.

## **CONTACT CONGRESSMEN MCKINLEY, MOONEY AND JENKINS TO ASK THEM TO VOTE TO PROHIBIT REVERSE AUCTIONS**

CAWV Members are asked to contact immediately West Virginia's House members and ask them to vote for an amendment to help prohibit reverse auctions on federal construction projects. See AGC's information below on the House Amendment. By using the link, you can access AGC's Legislative Action network to immediately send an e-mail to Representatives David McKinley, Alex Mooney and Evan Jenkins.

This week, the House will consider legislation that will help prohibit federal agencies from conducting reverse auctions for construction services. Please [contact your representative](#) and tell them to support the Hanna Amendment to the National Defense Authorization Act of FY 2016, which would help prohibit construction reverse auctions.

Reverse auctions do not work for construction services, which are project-specific, inherently variable and require expert knowledge. Federal agencies, including the Department of Veterans Affairs and Department of the Interior, are using reverse auctions to procure construction services for full-range construction projects, like complex and multifaceted building renovations and park roads. The General Services Administration has also established a reverse auction website through which ANY federal agency can procure construction services.

Please tell your federal representative to support the Hanna Amendment to stop these agencies from using reverse auctions for construction.

## **ACCIDENT PREVENTION**

As a construction worker you are part of a team of skilled professional craft workers, and accident prevention is part of your job. It takes everyone's effort to keep a jobsite safe. There are many things you can do to help prevent accidents. Come to work fully rested; wear proper clothing and sturdy footwear; jewelry, watches and rings must be left at home. Use the correct personal protective equipment when the task requires it, and keep this safety gear in good condition and replace it as necessary. Damaged or lost equipment should be reported to your supervisor. Keep your work area clean and neat. Don't let your housekeeping get out of hand.

Follow the warnings written on labels. Observe signs, regulations and procedures; ask your supervisor about any you don't understand. Never bypass safety valves or devices. Follow lock out - tag out practices where required to do so. Remove protruding nails or bend them over. Wipe up spills of oil, water, or grease. Keep walkways, aisles, traffic lanes and fire exits clear of debris and other materials. When working in new areas of the jobsite take a few minutes to look around to locate obvious hazards. Don't leave any floor openings unprotected. Cover floor holes securely or guard with standard guardrails. Make sure you have the right type and size of ladder. Climb it facing the rungs and be sure your hands are free to hold onto the ladder.

Check your electrical tools prior to use. Whenever possible plug into electrical outlets that are protected with GFCI'S. Do not use tools with split, broken, or loose handles. Watch out for overhead power lines. Always store flammable liquids in approved containers. Shut off engines and let them cool down prior to refueling; and never smoke around flammables. Report any accidents to your supervisor. If you get injured get proper first aid and seek medical assistance if necessary. Keep your mind on your work. Drugs and alcohol don't have a place on the job. Horseplay and practical jokes cause accidents so keep them off the job. Practice accident prevention. Try your best to follow these guidelines and all of us will have a safer place to work.

## **BLUE RIBBON COMMISSION REPORT TO BE RELEASED**

The final report of the Governor's Blue Ribbon Commission on Highways will be released May 21. The long-awaited report discusses ways to increase funding for highways and maintenance. "It's been a long struggle," said Administration Secretary Jason Pizatella, who serves as the commission's chairman. "I'm certainly pleased the final report will be issued."

Created by Gov. Earl Ray Tomblin in the summer of 2012, the 31-member panel of legislators, state and local officials, industry and labor representatives, scholars and citizens began meeting that September, with a mandate to come up with a long-term plan for the Mountain State's highway construction and maintenance needs. After about a year of study and public hearings, the panel concluded that West Virginia needs to double the roughly \$1.2 billion a year it spends on highways, to complete the highways system and adequately maintain it. In a preliminary report released in September 2013, the commission proposed a number of ways to increase highways funding, including significant increases in Division of Motor Vehicle fees and issuing \$1 billion in road bonds, to be paid off by keeping tolls on the West Virginia Turnpike through 2049.

Reaction to the preliminary recommendations was generally less than enthusiastic. Gov. Tomblin said at the time, "I'm not sure a bond issue of that magnitude at this time is something we want to get into, but I'll reserve judgment until I see the final report." Republicans in the House and Senate spoke out against the proposals, with Delegate Marty Gearhart, R-Mercer, who is now chairman of the House Transportation Committee, calling the report "a colossal failure." Since then, issuance of the final report has been postponed repeatedly. Most recently, a planned September 2014 release was pushed back to November, and then later delayed until after completion of the 2015 legislative session.

Pizatella said Thursday the final report is essentially unchanged from the preliminary plan issued in 2013. "It's not going to plow much new ground," he said. "It's just a final report that ties everything together."

## **DOH STEPS UP LAW ENFORCEMENT IN WORK ZONE AREAS**

"Just slow down" is the message the state Division of Highways wants West Virginia motorists to know while driving through work zones across the state. The DOH is working with the West Virginia State Police and other law enforcement agencies to increase enforcement in those targeted areas through September. "Speeding through a work zone is a serious issue and we

feel like we needed to really make a statement to slow people down in work zones,” said Brent Walker, spokesman with the DOH.

The Charleston Police Department and the DOH held a press conference to discuss their enforcement efforts throughout the summer months. Cpl. Brian Jones said officers will be on site all hours of the day and said they are not publicizing when those times will be. He said officers will be there to issue speeding tickets for those motorists speeding through the construction zones. Since the work began along Interstate 64 in Charleston March 27, Jones said they have had 22 motor vehicle accidents. Jones said they issued 20 speeding tickets along I-64 in a single hour and a half timeframe. Jones said speeding in a construction zone results in a \$200 fine and 20 days in regional jail.

# West Virginia desperately needs to invest in roads, bridges

There have been a number of recent letters to the editor noting the condition of West Virginia's roads and highways.

There is no question the state's highway and bridge network is facing a number of challenges. Demand for passenger and freight traffic continues to increase as the system is aging and conditions are deteriorating.

West Virginia is only one of four states in which there is no county ownership of highways. As a result, the state's Division of Highways (DOH) is responsible for the construction and maintenance of 94 percent of the public highway mileage, making West Virginia the sixth largest state-maintained network in the nation.

While West Virginia has greatly expanded and improved its transportation system, the cost to maintain and expand it is reaching a critical stage. Our highways and bridges are struggling under ever growing maintenance needs, increasing inflationary impacts and greater use of vehicles.

Most of your readers have seen the statistics that show that 36 percent of West Virginia's major roads have pavements rated in poor or mediocre condition and that 35 percent of the bridges are rated as structurally deficient or functionally obsolete. In addition, the value of truck freight shipments is expected to almost double by 2040, with a significant impact on congestion across the state's road and bridge network.

The DOH does a good job with the limitations it works under. In 1999, DOH revenues were \$1.9 billion in constant 2012 dollars compared to \$1.2 billion in 2012. Therefore, the value of current revenue is only 62 percent of what it was in 1999, with the funding gap widening every day.

The state gas tax and federal gas tax, which fund the majority of all state and highway bridge projects, haven't been raised since 1993. In the 22 years since, the gas tax has lost 38 percent of its spending power, even as our infrastructure needs continue to grow.

Congress needs to enact a long-term sustainable revenue source for the federal Highway Trust Fund or face another shutdown of the highway construction program, which almost occurred in July 2014. Congress passed a temporary federal aid highway bill that is set to expire May 31.

While Congress continues to debate how to pay for our aging roads and bridges, many states are not standing idly by. Pennsylvania, Virginia, Maryland and Ohio have raised revenues to address their transportation infrastructure needs.

West Virginia must develop additional revenue streams to give its DOH the ability to plan for improvements, expansions and other major programs to ensure our safety, mobility and quality of life.



Additional funding not only begins the process to repair and expand our deteriorating highway systems, it creates jobs. A recent report by the American Road and Transportation Builders Association shows that an additional \$500 million state investment in transportation annually would generate nearly 10,000 new jobs (47 percent in the nonconstruction industry sector) and support a billion dollars in economic activity.

The study confirms what your readers already know. West Virginia is in urgent need to invest in its highway and bridge system.
