## **BLUE RIBBON COMMISSION ON HIGHWAYS RELEASES INFRASTRUCTURE REPORT**

Governor Earl Ray Tomblin's Blue Ribbon Commission on Highways (BRC) has released the long awaited report, which assesses West Virginia's infrastructure needs and outlines the steps the state should take to address maintenance and improvement issues. Gov. Tomblin created the BRC in August 2012, mandating that the panel — made up of legislators, state and local officials, industry and labor representatives, scholars and citizens — study the state's highways needs and come up with a long-term funding plan.

The report acts as a road map for policy makers, offering a baseline of recommendations and outlining the problems our roads and bridges face. It states that the state requires approximately \$750 million a year to satisfy current infrastructure demands and also calls for continued study of road funding innovations. The report says new sources of revenue could include: motor vehicle taxes — increasing motor vehicle sales tax from 5 to 6 percent and generating about \$40 million; registration fees — increasing DMV registration and motor vehicle licensing fees and index for inflation could bring in \$75 million; alternative fuel vehicle registration fee — assess an annual registration fee on "Alternative Fuel Vehicles" by implementing an annual registration fee of \$200 for alternative fuel vehicles and a \$100 fee for electric cars bringing in an estimated \$1 million; other tax revenue — dedicating the consumer sales and use tax revenue already collection from purchases associated with cars and trucks estimating a general revenue of about \$25 million.

The Turnpike could also play a vital role in bumping up road revenues and could pave the way for road improvements all over the state. The report proposes a 10 percent to 25 percent toll increase in 2016 and additional increases every other year for at least 10 years. However, the commission proposes freezing toll rates for West Virginia EZPass users for the first five years. If the West Virginia Turnpike is turned over to the West Virginia Division of Highways in 2019, another \$59 million gets added to the cost of highway maintenance.

Secretary of Administration Jason Pizatella, who serves as chairman of the BRC, stated that he wants to take action on the report and is recommending that Gov. Tomblin hold a meeting with legislative leaders to work on the next steps toward addressing highway funding. "We have to recognize the critical importance highway infrastructure that's modern and safe has for economic development in the state," he said.

### **JOINT SELECT COMMITTEE ON TAX REFORM DISCUSSES EFFORTS**

Members of the Joint Committee on Tax Reform met in Charleston this week to carry on the new committee's quest to improve the business climate in West Virginia. The agenda included an overview of state tax issues and trends and tax reform efforts in other states. The group looked to leaders from national policy and tax reform organizations to learn about the progress, or in some cases regress, other states are making as they take on changes in their tax codes. Panel members include West Virginia University College of Business and Economics dean Jose V. "Zito" Sartarelli, WVU Bureau of Business and Economic Research director John Deskins, and Marshall University Center of Business and Economic Research director Jennifer Shand. During their next meeting, scheduled for June 9, the committee will hear from city and county governments on the taxation powers they have and whether those powers should be expanded. At a later meeting in June, lawmakers will focus solely on the state's real estate, including property, taxes.

### **ARTBA LEADERS ATTEND WHITE HOUSE TRANSPORTATION EVENT**

Several ARTBA members represented the industry at a May 14 White House event intended to promote the Obama Administration's transportation policy and funding priorities. Key speakers at "Conditions for Growth: The Economic Benefits of a Robust Federal Transportation Program" included U.S. Treasury Secretary Jack Lew, Office of Management & Budget Director Shaun Donovan and National Economic Council Director Jeff Zients. John Boyle, president of Mountaineer Contractors, Inc. and CAWV Highway/Heavy Division chairman, was one of the ARTBA leaders in attendance. Chairman Boyle and other ARTBA leaders discussed the merits of the administration's GROW AMERICA reauthorization proposal, which would include a large surface transportation investment increase funded by a potential tax reform package. ARTBA thanks its members, many of whom traveled long distances, for representing the industry on this occasion.

## **AGC-BACKED BAN ON REVERSE AUCTIONS PASSES HOUSE VOTE**

The U.S. House of Representatives passed a provision that would help prevent federal agencies from procuring construction services through reverse auctions. Representative Richard Hanna (R-N.Y.) offered this AGC-supported provision as an amendment—which passed by unanimous voice vote—to the National Defense Authorization Act of 2016. The Defense Act – with the reverse auction ban amendment included – subsequently passed the House on a 269 to 151 vote late last week. The Act funds for the Department of Defense and has passed Congress every year for over 50 consecutive years.

The House-passed defense measure also included provisions that encourage sensible consideration of past performance records in joint ventures and teaming, prevent individual surety fraud in the construction bond marketplace and address the unintended consequences of misinterpretation of the U.S. Small Business Administration's non manufacturer rule. AGC testified on these and other procurement reforms before the House Small Business Committee in February. AGC is working with members of the Senate to add similar construction procurement reform measures to its version of the Defense Act. The Senate is currently scheduled to consider the bill in June.

West Virginia Congressmen Alex Mooney, McKinley and Evan Jenkins all voted to support the Hanna Amendment. Thanks to all the CAWV members who took action and contacted our congressional delegation on the issue.

## **PREVENTING BACKOVERS**

Road construction workers face many hazards on the job. In addition to many of the hazards present on a “traditional” construction site, road workers also need to contend with moving vehicles both in and around the job site. From 1995 through 2002, 844 fatal occupational injuries occurred at road construction sites. The majority of these fatalities, 693 (82%) cases, were reported to be transportation incidents. Fatalities involving a ground worker being struck by a vehicle or equipment accounted for 509 (73%) of the transportation incidents. Victims were as likely to be struck by construction equipment (32%) as by highway vehicles (28%).

The leading cause of fatalities for workers in work zones is being run over or backed over by construction equipment. While we often worry about construction workers being killed by motorists, road workers working behind the barriers in the work zone are at equal risk of being killed by construction vehicles due to their large “blind spots.” Each month, at least one worker is killed by being backed over by a construction vehicle, often a dump truck. These deaths are completely preventable. One way to prevent these fatalities is to implement traffic patterns on jobsites to reduce the amount of backing up that is necessary and minimize the exposure of workers on foot to vehicles. This is called developing an Internal Traffic Control Plan or ITCP.

There is also a lot of new technology to help prevent workers from being struck such as cameras, radar, and wearable back up alarms. ## REPORT SAYS WEST VIRGINIA RURAL ROADS, BRIDGES AMONG WORST IN NATION

A new report states that West Virginia's rural roads and bridges are among the worst in the nation. The report by TRIP, a Washington-based non-profit transportation research group, examined traffic fatalities and road and bridge conditions in rural areas. The report states that 29 percent of major rural roads in West Virginia were in poor condition in 2013. That's the sixth highest rate in the nation. West Virginia's rural traffic fatality rate in 2013 was 2.61 deaths in 2013 for every 100 million vehicle miles of travel, the seventh highest rate in the nation. The report said 13 percent of West Virginia's rural bridges were structurally deficient in 2014. That's the 16th highest rate in the nation.

“While Congress continues to debate how to pay for our aging roads and bridges, many states are taking action,” said Carol Fulks, chairperson for West Virginians for Better Transportation (WVBT). “Virginia, Ohio, Maryland and Pennsylvania have raised revenues to address their transportation infrastructure needs. West Virginia should also step up to the plate to develop additional revenue sources to give the West Virginia Division of Highways the ability to plan for improvements, expansions and other major programs to ensure our safety, mobility and quality of life.”

### **HOUSE APPROVES TWO-MONTH TRANSPORTATION EXTENSION**

The House voted to extend federal Highway Trust Fund financing for two months, another in a series of short-term extensions that has frustrated business and transportation groups. The temporary reauthorization, which passed 387-35, is expected to clear the Senate later this week. It would keep highway and transit funding flowing through the end of July without the need for new revenue. The Highway Trust Fund faces insolvency sometime this summer, according to the nonpartisan Congressional Budget Office. Since 2011, lawmakers have settled for a series of short-term extensions. The last long-term reauthorization was a six-year bill enacted in 2005.

### **NEW ARTBA VIDEO HIGHLIGHTS HISTORY OF INFRASTRUCTURE LEADERSHIP**

A new ARTBA video gives historical perspective to the contemporary problem of fixing the Highway Trust Fund (HTF) to repair and build the nation's transportation infrastructure. The video shows how five American presidents, working with Congress during their administrations, were able to build important projects such as the C&O Canal, the Transcontinental Railroad, the Panama Canal, the Interstate Highway System and the moon landing. George Washington, Abraham Lincoln, Theodore Roosevelt, Dwight Eisenhower and Jack Kennedy, together with the congressional leaders of their day, "didn't punt," the video shows. It notes that "Leadership = Infrastructure Investment." The 90-second video urges President Obama and Congress: "Don't Punt: Fix the Highway Trust Fund."
