## **WV BUSINESS & INDUSTRY COUNCIL HOSTS EASTERN PANHANDLE ECONOMIC SUMMIT**

More than 170 people from the Eastern Panhandle attended the August 12 edition of “Policy and Progress,” a statewide business forum series by the WV Business & Industry Council (BIC). Held in conjunction with the Eastern Panhandle Business Association at the Hollywood Casino in Charles Town, the forum was kicked off with remarks by Attorney General Patrick Morrisey, House Speaker Tim Armstead and Senate President Bill Cole. The agenda included a series of panel discussions on tax reform, education, legal and regulatory reform, workforce freedom, tourism, energy and infrastructure and economic development. Each panel included members of the Eastern Panhandle legislative delegation and local experts.

John Reisenweber, executive director of the Jefferson County Development Authority said growth is straining everything in the Eastern Panhandle and that the state needs to continually invest in infrastructure. “We can’t keep up with growth when we cut \$30 million from the WV Infrastructure and Jobs Development Council. Reisenweber, who is vice chair of the council, was referring to the \$20 million diversion last year and \$10 million this year from the council’s budget to help balance the state’s general fund budget. Reisenweber also commented that “if he’s heard it once, he’s heard it 100 times from manufacturers who want to expand that they will not come to West Virginia because it is not a right-to-work state.”

Steve Christian, executive director of the Berkeley County Development Authority, discussed Proctor and Gamble’s new 3 million-plus square foot manufacturing facility near Martinsburg. “Proctor and Gamble wanted 350 acres, power, water, sewer, rail, fiber optic internet and natural gas,” he said. “There were lots of factors needed to win the Proctor and Gamble deal, but fundamentally, we needed to have a site big enough to accommodate them in Berkeley County, and the site had to be equipped with infrastructure to meet their needs. We can’t build our manufacturing sector with a natural gas pipeline.”

## **FY16 HOUSE AND SENATE INTERIOR APPROPRIATIONS BILL**

As Congress heads into the August recess, the appropriation process has come to a grinding halt. It appears that a Continuing Resolution (CR) will be needed to continue funding for the Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) and the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF). The timing and duration of a CR is still unknown. Normally, the CAWV has not supported CRs but in this case, the Fiscal Year 2015 funding levels are much better than the FY 16 proposed levels so a CR would continue funding at the current level.

House and Senate Appropriation bills are calling for drastic cuts to clean water and drinking water funding. The House and Senate Appropriations Committees have recently approved the federal Fiscal Year 2016 spending bills for the Interior, Environment and Related Agencies. Contained in this measure is FY 2016 funding for the Environmental Protection Agency and the Clean Water and Drinking Water SRF programs. Both the House and Senate measures cut the existing SRF programs by approximately 23%. Specifically, the House bill provides total SRF funding of \$1.775 billion, \$1.018 billion for the Clean Water SRF and \$757 million for the Drinking Water SRF, which results in a 23% decrease in funding from federal FY 2015 (a 30% CWSRF and 16% DWSRF respectively).

The Senate appropriations measure also cuts the combined funding for EPA's Clean Water and Drinking Water SRFs by 23%, to \$1.8 billion, from current year's spending. The detailed spending amounts for each SRF will be available soon but are expected to be similar to the House proposal.

## **WVDOH REVENUES FOR JULY RELEASED**

State Road Fund revenues for the first month of the 2016 Fiscal Year are already behind estimates and actual 2015 revenues. Total collections for July were \$62.8 million, down \$3 million from the Governor's estimate of \$65.9 million and \$6.2 million under last July's revenue of \$69 million. Gas tax and Registration revenue account for the drop. Privilege tax revenue is running above projections. At \$20.5 million in collection, the Privilege tax is \$3 million over the Governor's estimate and \$6.4 million above 2015 figures. Motor Fuel taxes at \$35.4 million are \$3 million under the Governor's estimate and \$3.5 million under last year's total. Registration fees at \$6.6 million and \$3.2 million under the Governor's estimate and \$9.2 million under last year's July figure.

## **DRIVE ACT SUMMARY AVAILABLE**

## **PENNDOT POSTS STRONG JULY LETTING PERIOD**

PennDOT continued its strong, post-Act 89 momentum by letting just over \$340 million in projects during July, bringing the year-to-date total to just over \$1.7 billion. Last year, PennDOT ended the year with \$2.6 billion in lettings, the highest since 2009 when the program was boosted by the one-time economic stimulus package. PennDOT exceeded its initial 2014 estimate of \$2.2 billion and it was reported earlier that PennDOT's 2015 anticipated lettings will again be \$2.6 billion.

At the end of 2013, PennDOT only bid \$1.638 billion in lettings. Act 89 enabled PennDOT to put nearly a \$1 billion more projects on the street in 2014 than it was able to do in 2013. With the recent enactment of the transportation funding bill there is reason to see this trend continue well past 2015. Act 89, which will implement a \$2.3 billion comprehensive transportation funding plan over the next five years, will result in PennDOT exceeding the \$2 billion construction lettings mark for years to come. *(Reprinted from Pennsylvania Highway Information Association, August 3, 2015 Newsletter)*
