Gov. Jim Justice announced that he has appointed Daniel Linville of Cabell County to the House of Delegates District 16 seat, representing Cabell and Lincoln counties, filling a vacancy created after the resignation of the Honorable C.E. Romine. Linville is a small business owner and resident of Milton and was endorsed in the Primary election by HUB/PAC, the CAWV's political action committee.

THIRD SET OF 2018 CAWV/WVDOH TECHNICIAN AND INSPECTOR COURSES ADDED

The CAWV is pleased to announce that due to demand a third set of Technician Certification Training Courses has been added to the training schedule. The courses, which are offered annually to help individuals prepare for WVDOH certification examinations required under their Quality Assurance Program, have seen greater demand this year due to the passage of the "Roads to Prosperity Bond Amendment". Thousands of individuals have attended courses in Compaction, Aggregates, Asphalt and Portland Cement Concrete over the last several years. Test comparisons prove that those persons who attend the CAWV/WVDOH courses have a higher success rate for passing the exams. Members can see this week's Highway/Heavy Bulletin for more information.

FLOOD DEMOLITION SINGLE HOUSING CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS ADVERTISED

This week the state Purchasing Division released contracts to replace homes damaged by the June 2016 floods. These projects are separate from the RISE program that has been the subject of recent media and legislative scrutiny. These projects are advertised by the Commerce Department but are under the management of the National Guard. Gov. Justice appointed Gen. James Hoyer to oversee flood reconstruction efforts when it was determined that only about \$1.7 million of the available \$150 million in HUD funds had been allocated to flood recovery.

The CAWV met with Gen. Hoyer and officials from the Governor's Office to determine how CAWV members can assist in flood relief efforts. After the meeting, the guard and Purchasing developed four separate contracts: 1/ Construct new residential housing; 2/ Repair damaged homes; 3/ Mobile home facilities; and 4/ Demolition of damaged structures. Today's Building Bulletin contains the new residential housing contracts. Contractors bidding will have to provide bonds and insurance as well as meet all state purchasing requirements.

General Hoyer told the CAWV this week that he expects the state will receive millions in additional U.S. HUD funding which will be used for mitigation projects, many of which will be for water and sewer projects. See this week's Municipal/Utility Bulletin for further information.

CONSTRUCTION EMPLOYMENT INCREASES IN 272 METRO AREAS; WEIRTON-STEUBENVILLE, WV RANKED THIRD

Construction employment increased in 272 (76 percent) out of 358 metro areas between June 2017 and June 2018, declined in 44 (12 percent) and was unchanged in 42, according to a new analysis of federal employment data released this week by the Associated General Contractors of America. Association officials noted that, for now at least, the growing economy and strong demand for construction services appear to be offsetting cost increases caused by significant labor shortages and newly-imposed trade tariffs. "Increases in construction employment in the past year were widespread and strong, as employment increased in three-fourths of metro areas," said Ken Simonson, the association's chief economist. "Workers in most metro areas are benefitting as firms keep pace with strong demand for construction services."

The Houston-The Woodlands-Sugar Land, Texas metro area added the most construction jobs during the past year (19,300 jobs, 9 percent), followed by Phoenix-Mesa-Scottsdale, Ariz. (13,100 jobs, 11 percent); and Dallas-Plano-Irving, Texas. The largest percentage gain occurred

in Merced, Calif. (700 jobs, 28 percent), followed by Midland, Texas (6,700 jobs, 24 percent); and Weirton-Steubenville, W.Va.-Ohio (19 percent, 300 jobs). Read full news release [here](#).

OSHA PROPOSES TO REVISE ITS 2016 ELECTRONIC RECORDKEEPING RULE

On July 27, the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) issued a notice of proposed rulemaking to amend the 2016 recordkeeping rule. This proposal would rescind a requirement that contractors with 250 or more employees electronically submit detailed information from their OSHA Forms 300 (Log of Work-Related Injuries and Illnesses) and 301 (Injury and Illness Incident Report), a requirement from which smaller contractors were already exempted. OSHA cited the need to protect sensitive worker information from disclosure under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), the cost to the agency to collect and utilize the information, and the burden on contractors to comply with the current rule as justification for the proposed amendments.

What the proposal does not address are the anti-retaliation interpretations related to safety incentive programs, disciplinary programs, and post-incident drug testing policies. These interpretations continue to be of concern and AGC will again submit comments strongly recommending the agency reconsider their position. *For more information please contact Kevin Cannon at (703) 837-5410 or cannonk@agc.org. FILING PERIOD SET FOR SUPREME COURT SEAT

Gov. Jim Justice on Monday issued a proclamation officially calling a special election to fill a vacancy on the West Virginia Supreme Court of Appeals. The proclamation came three days after the effective date of Menis Ketchum's resignation from the court amid an investigation into possible impeachment against the Supreme Court justices. The special election for the court will take place during the general election on Nov. 6. No state Supreme Court justice seats were up for election prior to Ketchum announcing his resignation on July 11. The person who wins the election will serve the remainder of Ketchum's term, which ends in 2020.

The governor also is responsible for appointing a person to serve on the Supreme Court during the interim period leading up to the election. Those interested in seeking election to the unexpired term on the Supreme Court may file with the Secretary of State's Office between Aug. 6 and midnight Aug. 21, Secretary of State Mac Warner said in a news release Monday evening. Since 2016, elections for judicial positions in West Virginia have been nonpartisan.

STAYING COOL ON THE JOBSITE THIS SUMMER

When the mercury starts climbing, keeping a hard-working crew cool and safe on the job site is something any contractor has to give thought to. Heat stress can contribute to fatigue and inattention, which can lead to mistakes on the job or even accidents. That's why it's a good idea for you to conduct safety meetings at the start of the summer so that all of your employees can review how they can keep cool in the heat. Below are a few tips for doing just that.

Make sure everyone stays hydrated!

Yes, this one may seem blatantly obvious. But even so, many workers fail to drink enough water on a hot day. One of the reasons is that plain water is boring, which is why you want to make sure you provide flavored electrolyte drinks like Gatorade. Even a bit of lemon squeezed into a cooler can add a little flavor. Also, these drinks help to replace the electrolytes the body uses up when it's sweating. While bosses used to distribute salt tablets to workers, this is unnecessary. We get plenty of salt from all the junk food we consume to replace any salt we lose by sweating.

The food your workers eat is also an important consideration. Large quantities of food with fat and calories are going to put a big load on their digestive system, which in turn places stress on the body when it's already trying to deal with the heat. Instead, your workers should eat a large breakfast and a light lunch, such as a salad or fruit (burgers and fries are out).

One way to minimize the problems your workers will face in the heat is to avoid that heat. Consider rescheduling outside work for early in the morning or at night. In addition to the modified work schedule, your foreman should allow for more breaks during the day. If workers are going to be taking breaks in an air-conditioned space, make sure they have dry shirts to change into. While this isn't always possible, whenever it is you should provide umbrellas, canopies or awnings to keep your workers out of direct sunlight. Even if it only provides partial protection, having a little shade to hop into from time to time is better than having none at all. You should also make sure that you provide high SPF sunblock for all crewmembers working outside. In addition, you might want to provide wide brim hard hats. Neck protectors, cooling vests, vented hard hats and bandannas are also effective ways to keep cool while working in the sun.

You and your foreman should keep a close eye out for any indications of heat exhaustion among your workers. Odd behavior can be one sign of heat exhaustion and must be addressed immediately. Some of the symptoms of heat exhaustion include disorientation, weakness, slurred speech and dropping tools. Obviously, this isn't the kind of thing you want to happen when someone is operating heavy machinery or using dangerous tools.

Note: If someone is suffering from heat exhaustion, he or she should rest in a cool location with their feet elevated. Remove their work boots and position fans to lower their body temperature. Provide plenty of water. If they are unconscious or unresponsive, contact 911 immediately.

STATE SEEKING FEDERAL FLOOD MITIGATION FUNDS FOR WATER AND SEWER REPAIR PROJECTS

The WV National Guard is now overseeing the 2016 flood repair program previously administered by the RISE program. Past CAWV newsletters, and today's CAWV Building Bulletin, detail the demolition, mobile home pads and new home construction projects advertised through the WV Purchasing Division.

The CAWV has been coordinating with the Governor's Office and General James Hoyer to make sure West Virginia contractors are able to participate in the flood recovery projects. General Hoyer notified the CAWV this week that the state is expecting to get millions more in additional U.S. HUD funding for mitigation purposes. This will include many water and sewer repair and renovation projects in the affected West Virginia counties. The association will be meeting with the general's staff to determine the scope and time table for advertising and bidding the projects. Look in future CAWV Municipal/Utility Bulletins for details.

SENATE PASSES FUNDING BILL IMPACTING WATER INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS

Prior to leaving for a two-week recess, the Senate overwhelmingly passed a package containing funding for federal programs impacting highway and transit as well as drinking water and waste water construction projects, among other things. House and Senate leaders intend to finalize funding for these programs and send a bill to the president for signature prior to the end of the fiscal year on September 30. The bill would also increase funding for Clean Water and Drinking Water State Revolving Funds, the total of which is set at \$2.86 billion. Additionally, the bill would provide \$63 million for the Water Infrastructure Finance and Innovation Act program and \$50 million for the Diesel Emissions Reduction Act grant program. Lastly, the bill would allocate level funding for the Rural Utilities Service, Water and Waste Disposal Program of \$1.25 billion. The CAWV will be advocating House members to support the Senate levels.

EPA ADMINISTRATOR COMMITS TO REVIEWING EPA'S 404 PERMIT VETO AUTHORITY
