## **CONSTRUCTION EMPLOYMENT FIGURES RELEASED - WEST VIRGINIA MOVES TO #7**

Forty-three states and the District of Columbia added construction jobs between June 2017 and June 2018, while 32 states and D.C. added construction jobs between May and June, according to an analysis by the Associated General Contractors of America of Labor Department data. While other states numbers continue to increase, West Virginia has dropped to seventh with 2,200 jobs added, a 7.1 percent increase. West Virginia lost the highest percentage of construction jobs for the month (-2.1 percent, -700 jobs), followed by South Carolina and Ohio. West Virginia led the nation for five consecutive months for the largest percentage of new construction jobs. As demand for construction in most parts of the country continues to expand and the number of unemployed construction workers hits record low levels, AGC of America and Autodesk are working to better quantify where these shortages are taking place, how severe they are, and what steps firms are taking to both cope with tight labor markets and improve the supply of new, qualified workers. That is why they are asking members to take a few minutes to complete the workforce survey that AGC has prepared. The more people understand the scope, and consequences, of a tight construction labor market, the more likely they are to act on the measures we are promoting to make it easier for school systems, local associations and private firms to establish career and technical education and training programs. ### **RCBI AND USSBA OFFER HUBZONE WORKSHOPS IN WEST VIRGINIA**

Join the Robert C. Byrd Institute in partnership with the U.S. Small Business Administration (SBA) in a series of free HUBZone workshops across West Virginia. The workshops will help members understand how to apply the requirements of the HUBZone Program to help small businesses receive their fair share of contracting opportunities. A HUBZone is an SBA program for small companies that operate and employ people in Historically Underutilized Business Zones. Morning sessions will provide an overview of HUBZones: what they are, where they are and how to become certified. Afternoon sessions will focus on where to find HUBZone contracting opportunities and how to navigate the application process.

## **AGC-BACKED CHANGE ORDER REFORM BILL PASSES HOUSE**

The recently released fiscal year 2019 National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA) Conference Report includes the AGC-backed bipartisan legislation that will require federal agencies to publish their change orders policy and procedures on any small business federal construction contract. This legislation provides prospective federal construction contractors with the information they need to help factor into their bids and offers the risk and resulting cost of delayed payment for change order work. The House of Representatives passed the FY 2019 NDAA on July 26 before leaving Washington, D.C. for the August recess. The Senate is expected to pass the legislation sometime before the end of the year.

This legislation is a product from a congressional hearing where AGC members testified before the House Small Business Committee on change order delays and the impacts it has on federal construction contractors. The Senate is expected to pass the NDAA in the coming months. Once signed into law, this new transparency requirement will need to go through the rulemaking process.

AGC continues to be at the forefront in advocating for greater accountability of the change order process among the various federal agencies. AGC has previously called on the Federal Acquisition Regulation Council to improve the data federal agencies collect regarding the administration of change orders in response to the Council's information request. AGC's recommendations would require federal agencies to collect a range of data regarding the timeliness of action by the contracting officer to encourage greater accountability.

## BASIC MACHINE SAFETY

It's tough to imagine modern society without machines hard at work all around us. New and improved machinery leads to increased productivity, higher quality, and more affordable production. But misused machines can be as harmful as they are helpful. Machines that cut metal can cut off fingers. Machines that punch through steel can punch through flesh. Such injuries can cause career-ending disabilities as well as severe pain and suffering. Be alert to these areas when working around or operating machinery:

**The point of operation:** That is where the work of the machine takes place. It's where the pressing, cutting, punching and boring takes place. It's a place where no part of the body should be. If any part of the body is in the way at the point of operation, the force of the machine can cause a serious injury. The point of operation may also produce sparks or fragments that can fly toward the operator. Safety glasses are important for this type of work.

**The power train:** That is where energy is transferred through moving parts like gears, shafts, belts, cables, hydraulic or pneumatic cylinders. No body parts should be in these areas either. When working on this type of machinery, always follow the lockout/tagout procedures and replace all guards when repairs are complete. Employees should report any missing guards to their supervisor before operating this equipment.

Workers must control machines carefully. In addition to avoiding the power train and point of operation, employees should always:

- Make sure machines are anchored securely to prevent "walking," tipping, excessive vibration or other movement that could be hazardous.
- Never reach blindly into areas that may contain energized parts.
- Be sure there is enough lighting to clearly see all points of operation.
- Keep conductive items -- watches, rings, steel wool, belt buckles away from exposed electrical parts.
- Never plug or unplug electrical equipment with wet hands.
- Follow all lockout/tag-out procedures.
- Always wear the proper protective equipment for each job.

**Material handling equipment:** Power lifts, forklift trucks, etc. are not considered to be production machinery, but their points of operation and power train can be just as hazardous. Employees must be properly trained in the operation of this type of equipment before they are allowed to use it.

## CHAIRMAN SHUSTER RELEASES PROPOSAL TO FIX HIGHWAY TRUST FUND

House Transportation & Infrastructure Committee Chairman Bill Shuster (R-PA) released a discussion draft of a bill to fix and reform the Highway Trust Fund, extend the FAST Act by one year to 2021, and accelerate project delivery. The draft calls for phasing in a 15-cent gasoline and a 20-cent diesel user fee increase over three years and then indexing the fee to inflation, creating a 10 percent user fee on electric batteries, establishing a 10 percent user fee on adult bicycle tires, and eliminating full and partial fuel tax exemptions for public transit and intercity buses. All user fees would be extended through 2028 to create enough revenue for a six-year reauthorization of the FAST Act.

The draft also repeals a looming \$7.6 billion rescission of federal highway funding scheduled to take effect in 2020, authorizes a more transparent earmarking process for the TIGER and



INFRA grant programs, and promotes asset management and public-private partnerships without expanding toll pilot programs. The draft also accelerates project delivery by proposing to make permanent the Trump Administration's "One Federal Decision" policy, which sets a schedule for a record of decision on environmental reviews within two years, expands categorical exclusions, creates a pilot program to allow innovative approaches to environmental review in lieu of the NEPA process, and reforms clean water permitting.

Chairman Shuster's plan is not to formally introduce a bill but to allow the draft to generate discussion on the merits of this approach to fixing the Highway Trust Fund. A formal bill will not be introduced before November elections. ### **WVDOH ISSUES NEW PROVISION FOR WEST VIRGINIA JOBS ACT**

A new special provision of the West Virginia Jobs Act has been included in WVDOH contract documents available through Bid Xpress. The new provision, dated June 19, 2018, explains contractor and subcontractor's requirements on projects over \$500,000 to hire at least 75% of their workers for the project from the local labor market. The local labor market as defined by the Act includes all counties in West Virginia and any county outside of West Virginia if any portion of that county is within fifty (50) miles of the West Virginia border. If workers are not available from inside the local labor market, the contractor shall contact the nearest office of Workforce West Virginia and provide the following information: the number of qualified employees needed and a job description of the vacant positions within 3 business days, Workforce shall issue a waiver to the Prime or Subcontractor.

The main change in the June 19, 2018 provision is that the only information required on the certified payroll is the occupation, County and State of primary residence for each employee. No other information will be needed or required.

Any Prime Contractor or Subcontractor found to be in violation of the Act will be subject to a civil penalty of \$250 per each employee less than the required threshold of 75% per day. Any Prime Contractor or Subcontractor in violation for more than 14 calendar days after receipt of a "Notice of Violation" from the Division of Labor is subject to a civil penalty of \$500 per each employee less than the required threshold of 75% per day.

### **FLOOD DEMOLITION / CONSTRUCTION / RECONSTRUCTION PROJECTS ADVERTISED**

The state Purchasing Division released this week various contracts to repair and replace homes damaged by the June 2016 floods. These projects are separate from the RISE program that has been the subject of recent media and legislative scrutiny. These projects will be advertised by the Commerce Department but will be under the management of the National Guard. Gov. Justice appointed Gen. James Hoyer to oversee flood reconstruction efforts when it was determined that only about \$1.7 million of the available \$150 million in HUD funds had been allocated to flood recovery.

The CAWV met a few weeks ago with Gen. Hoyer and officials from the Governor's Office to determine how CAWV members could assist in flood relief efforts.
