PREVAILING WAGE REFORM BILL ADDED TO STATE MEETING PROGRAM

Gov. Tomblin signed into law Thursday S.B. 361, the prevailing wage reform bill. It becomes effective April 13, 2015. The new bill, and how it will affect public construction projects, will be discussed at the CAWV State Meeting breakfast, which will be held Wednesday, March 25. Prevailing wage rates will no longer apply to publicly funded projects under \$500,000 after April 13, and after July 1, new prevailing wage rates must be determined and in place for the remainder of 2015. The procedure for determining prevailing wage rates and what contractors must do to participate in the process will be the topic at the State Meeting breakfast, which begins at 7:30 a.m. at the Charleston Civic Center. The CAWV State Meeting is being held in conjunction with the WV EXPO, March 25 and 26.

Nearly 200 CAWV members and guests, along with state and federal contracting officials, attended the meeting last year, which is held during EXPO. CAWV CONGRESSIONAL FLY-IN SET FOR APRIL 15

The 27th annual CAWV Congressional Fly-In to Washington will be Wednesday, April 15. "This will be the first meeting with West Virginia's new congressmen, Alex Mooney and Evan Jenkins," stated CAWV President Dan Flesher. "It will also be the first meeting with Shelley Moore Capito as a U.S. Senator. We are looking forward to meeting with Reps. Mooney and Jenkins, as well as all of West Virginia's delegation, on issues affecting our members and our industry." LEGISLATURE MEETING CONTINUOUSLY TO MEET SATURDAY ADJOURNMENT DEADLINE

Committee meetings and floor sessions in both houses have been long this week as legislators advance legislation before the Saturday, March 14, midnight adjournment. Legislators will stay in session next week to finalize the budget but all bills must pass before the midnight deadline or they are dead for this session. A number of CAWV related bills are still in play today and tomorrow. A complete wrap up of this session will be in the Monday, March 16 CAWV Legislative Bulletin.

Action this week includes the Governor signing into law S.B. 361, the prevailing wage bill. In his announcement, the governor wrote, "While I understand not everyone is happy with this compromise, I'm grateful for the continued work of all involved who came together to address

the concerns of hardworking West Virginians while establishing a common sense approach to continued investments in our infrastructure.” (S.B. 361 will be discussed at the March 25 CAWV State Meeting).

The House voted 62-36-2 in favor of S.B. 409, the bill to prohibit Project Labor Agreements (PLAs) on publicly funded construction projects. The bill was not amended from the Senate version so it will go to the governor for his signature. H.B. 2820, a bill to amend the bill passed in 2014 modifying the state’s mechanics’ lien statute, died Thursday in Senate Judiciary Committee. The bill was introduced to address concerns expressed by subcontractors and suppliers in homebuilding projects. (Seminar 83 at WV EXPO will address the current mechanics’ lien requirements). S.B. 581 passed the House Thursday which puts the state’s Courtesy Patrol program back under the WV Division of Highways at a cost of \$4.2 million. The Senate Transportation and Infrastructure Committee dedicated its meeting Tuesday to S.B. 478, a bill to increase funding for the WV Division of Highways. While the bill will not be addressed the session, the CAWV had the opportunity to discuss the report, “The Economic Impact of an Annual \$500 Million Increase in Highway and Bridge Construction Investment in West Virginia.” The report shows that nearly 10,000 jobs would be created or supported and nearly \$1 billion would be generated in additional economic output. Following the press conference March 3 releasing the report’s findings, a copy of the report was presented to every legislator. President Bill Cole and House Speaker Tim Armstead were on MetroNews’ “Talkline” this week and acknowledged a problem with the lack of highway funds but did not have specifics on how to provide additional funds.

The House today passed S. B. 423, a bill to modify the above ground storage tank requirements. The bill reduces the amount of tanks which must be inspected by WVDEP. The bill was supported by business and industry but opposed by a number of environmental groups. It passed 78-21-1. The House also passed S.B. 390 which allows gas utility companies to accelerate their costs to replace and repair their underground lines. The House also passed S.B. 170, a bundled rules bill which includes quarry safety rules introduced by the WV Crushed Aggregates Council and the Office of Miners' Health, Safety and Training. On passage stage Saturday in the Senate are H.B. 2688, the horizontal well (pooling) bill, and H.B. 2571 which allows businesses and groups to pay for patching potholes.

COMPLACENCY

The term complacency has several definitions; perhaps the one most suitable (in the context of safety) is as follows, "a feeling of quiet pleasure or security, often while unaware of some potential danger, defect, or the like". Ironically, this feeling can develop from a perception that you live and work in a safe environment. An environment of few, if any, workplace incidents and when an incident does occur, it is often of a minor nature. The message here is, never let your guard down. We maintain our safety by doing just that, maintaining it.

The ways we maintain our safety:

- We maintain a safe workplace by following established protocols and procedures.
- We have daily safety meetings to discuss changes and potential hazards that develop from day to day on our worksite.
- We wear the appropriate PPE for the task at hand.
- We complete an FLRA and/or review a JSA before starting a task.
- We take a "Four Second Reset" to stop and think about the safety side of the task we're about to start.
- We manage our "Zone of Control" on the worksite. Hazards identified, eliminated or controlled. Maintaining housekeeping and organization. Other workers and/or mobile equipment coming into your work area.
- We report any and all perceived or potential hazards on the worksite.
- We report all near misses. When reported, we are able to collect information, identify trends, correct current problems, and prevent future incidents and injuries from happening.
- We coach, mentor and watch out for each other throughout the day.

A level of safety in the workplace where incidents are indeed a rare occurrence, does not guarantee future success, however it is an indication of a strong safety culture. It's up to all of us to never let our guard down. Continuous safety maintenance is the backbone of a strong safety culture and a truly safe workplace.

U.S. REPRESENTATIVE EVAN JENKINS ANNOUNCES WATER PROJECT FUNDING

U.S. Representative Evan Jenkins (R-W.Va.) announced that the communities of Alderson, Richwood and Union will receive more than \$900,000 in federal funding for three water and wastewater projects from the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers, Huntington District. The projects are:

- Alderson Wastewater Treatment Plant upgrades and lift station replacements. The project includes upgrades to the town's wastewater treatment plant and replacement of three lift stations in order to meet the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency and West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection discharge limitations for the Greenbrier River. Design is expected to be completed in the summer of 2015. The federal funds provided are \$550,000.
- Richwood Plant upgrade and water line extension project. The project will upgrade the water plant to meet health department requirements for 1,064 customers and extend public water service to approximately 118 new customers in the Hinkle Mountain/Little Laurel communities. The design will be completed in winter 2016. The federal funds provided are \$200,000.
- Union water extension project. The project will include the construction of a 276,000 gallon standpipe water tank and a 100,000 gallon standpipe water tank near the UTC Aerospace Systems plant. There will be 11,800 feet of water main along U.S. Route 219 from Union to the UTC plant, three new fire hydrants and a booster station. An additional benefit of this project is that it will be possible for Union to serve the community of Pickaway, which has approximately 100 homes. The design will be completed in the spring of 2016. The federal funds provided are \$185,000.

The Army Corps received the funds for these projects through the Southern West Virginia Environmental Restoration Infrastructure and Resources Protection Development Pilot Program, authorized by Section 340 of the Water Resources Development Act of 1992. The program provides design and construction assistance to non-federal interests for carrying out water-related environmental infrastructure and resource protection and development projects in southern West Virginia.
