### **GUBERNATORIAL CANDIDATES TO SPEAK AT EXPO**

The West Virginia Manufacturers Association's Marcellus to Manufacturing Development Conference (MMDC), which is being held at EXPO, will be the first event to feature all four gubernatorial candidates, Senator Bill Cole, Senator Jeff Kessler, Jim Justice and Booth Goodwin. Each candidate for governor will have the opportunity to speak directly to West Virginia's manufacturing sector about their plans for the Mountain State and answer a few questions from the moderator. Candidates will appear one at a time to allow MMDC participants to focus on each person individually. The forum will be held Thursday, March 24, from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m. in the Charleston Civic Center's Little Theater. All EXPO attendees are welcome to attend. ### **LEGISLATURE FAILS TO PASS BILL FOR ROADS AND JOBS**

The 2016 legislative session ended Saturday without passing [S.B. 555](#), a bill that would have generated over \$300 million annually in new funding to repair and construct highway and bridges and create nearly 4,000 jobs. The Senate passed the bill on a bipartisan vote of 25-9 but the bill never made it out of the House Finance Committee. The House leadership did not embrace any tax measures, including increasing the tobacco tax by 45 cents a pack, a proposal introduced by the governor that had broad-based support by smoking cessation advocates and retailers alike and would have solved the funding problems associated with the Public Employees Insurance Agency (PEIA).

Lawmakers entered this session with Governor Earl Ray Tomblin presenting his sixth and final State of the State Address by emphasizing the state budget projects deficits totaling \$800 million in the current and upcoming budget year. The governor called for "new ways to ensure our tax base is both more stable and more diverse." He proposed to do this by increasing the state tax on cigarettes by 45 cents a pack and placing a new 6 percent sales tax on cellphone and landline use. Combined, those taxes would have raised \$131.5 million in new revenue. The governor's proposed budget recommending withdrawing \$52 million from the state's Rainy Day Fund to make up a portion of the expected revenue shortfall this year.

The extended session on the budget ended Tuesday when House and Senate conferees could not reach agreement on a budget bill. The Senate proposed raising fees and taxes to offset the budget deficits. The House budget swept a number of agency accounts of \$70 million and transferred \$30 million from the state's Rainy Day Fund. Gov. Tomblin said he would veto any budget that used Rainy Day funds to pay for ongoing expenses and vowed to send legislators home until they could reach a consensus on how to proceed with a balanced budget bill. Late Monday, it was announced that state revenues, already distressed due to declining coal and oil and gas severance tax revenues, will have a projected shortfall of \$92.4 million greater than originally predicted due to continued downturns in global energy markets. The governor and legislative leaders decided Tuesday to adjourn the session and reconvene later this spring when there is a clearer picture of the state's financial picture.

CAWV members received the March 17 CAWV Legislative Bulletin which outlines the issues affecting members and the construction industry. In the bulletin, CAWV President Dan Cooperrider thanked all the members who contacted legislators to express their thoughts and opinions throughout the legislative session. ### **CAWV BID CLEARINGHOUSE HELPS WITH PROJECT SCHEDULING**

The CAWV Bid Clearinghouse has been a good tool in scheduling project bid dates. It helps maximize the number of bidders on a project by helping avoid conflicting bid dates. Architects and engineers have been calling CAWV Planroom Administrator Cheryl Clark to verify what dates are available to schedule their bid opening. She then checks the calendar to see if that date conflicts with another project. Architects and engineers can then decide to either keep their original bid date or change to another date. We have found over the years that contractors can better prepare if they have adequate time to put together a competitive bid. This is difficult to do when projects bid close to one another or on the same day.

Architects and engineers will receive a mailing this week introducing Rena Moles. The mailing will inform them that Rena will be handling a number of planroom activities, including the Bid Clearinghouse and project information. They will also be reminded that the CAWV wants plans and specs available in the CAWV Planroom. While contractors usually get their plans directly from the designer, many suppliers and subcontractors appreciate the plans being available for viewing in the CAWV Planroom.

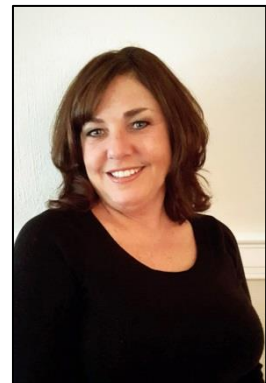

## **FEDERAL HIGHWAY FUNDING TOPIC OF TCC MEETING**

The Transportation Construction Coalition's (TCC) 2016 Legislative Fly-In is scheduled for May 10-11, 2016. While the Fixing America's Surface Transportation (FAST) Act provides a steady source of funding over the next five years for highway and transit programs, the legislation did not solve the long-term Highway Trust Fund revenue problem. At the expiration of the FAST Act in FY 2020, significant new revenue will be needed just to maintain current funding levels. Your Senators and Representative need to understand that they need to get started on fixing the transportation infrastructure investment shortfall we are facing now and into the future.

## **WVDOH HOLDS STATEWIDE ASPHALT PRECONSTRUCTION CONFERENCE— PRESENTATION AVAILABLE**

A number of issues and subjects were covered at the March 3 WVDOH Statewide Asphalt Preconstruction Conference held in conjunction with the 36<sup>th</sup> Annual Asphalt Paving Conference. ## **FHWA EXTENDS LOCAL HIRE PILOT PROGRAM**

The Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) this week extended for one year a pilot program allowing state DOTs to include a geographic-based (local) hiring preference as a contract requirement on federally-assisted highway construction projects. The pilot was originally set to expire on March 6, 2016. When first proposed US DOT simultaneously proposed a new rule allowing the use of local hire requirements on a permanent basis. Thus far eight states have asked for and received permission to use local hire requirements as part of the FHWA pilot program. US DOT has indicated that it intends to approve and evaluate the results of these projects under the pilot program before deciding how to proceed with its proposed rule.

AGC was successful in getting language in the 2016 Omnibus appropriations bill to set some statutory limits on the use of local hire requirements under this pilot program. States seeking to use local hire requirements as part of the pilot program must certify the following:

(1) that except with respect to apprentices or trainees, a pool of readily available but unemployed individuals possessing the knowledge, skill, and ability to perform the work that the contract requires resides in the jurisdiction;



(2) that the grant recipient will include appropriate provisions in its bid document ensuring that the contractor does not displace any of its existing employees in order to satisfy such hiring preference; and

(3) that any increase in the cost of labor, training, or delays resulting from the use of such hiring preference does not delay or displace any transportation project in the applicable Statewide Transportation Improvement Program or Transportation Improvement Program." FHWA sent a directive on January 8, to all of its state field offices establishing steps to comply with this provision.

US DOT has traditionally denied states the ability to use local hire requirements on federally assisted projects. Last year, however, DOT instituted the pilot program, under its existing Special Experimental Project No. 14 authority, allowing states to use local hire requirements on an experimental basis and issued a notice of proposed rulemaking proposing to allow the use of local hire requirements permanently in the future. [AGC submitted extensive comments](#) and a legal brief on the proposed rule.
