## **STATE REVENUES BETTER IN APRIL**

West Virginia Revenue Secretary Bob Kiss says the state is on target to finish the budget year without having to do “anything drastic or dramatic.” The state’s revenue picture improved after tax collections in April. Those collections exceeded estimates by nearly \$26.3 million, which is one of the best months of the fiscal year. The strong showing cut the revenue collection deficit by more than half. The year-to-date shortfall now stands at nearly \$24 million. “With the numbers we got in April, I think we’re on target to bring the year in balanced without any significant and highly painful other medicine or actions that need to be taken,” Kiss said.

The West Virginia Legislature passed bills this session that transferred money from the School Building Authority and WV Infrastructure Council to help balance the budget deficit. Taxes paid by residents and businesses at the April 15 tax deadline helped boost collections along with taxes paid on new vehicles, which continue to exceed estimates for the fiscal year. Kiss said an ongoing state hiring freeze has also helped. See the May 1, 2015 CAWV Heavy/Highway Bulletin for State Road Fund revenues through April.

## **TAX REFORM COMMITTEE EXAMINES WEST VIRGINIA TAX SYSTEM**

The Joint Select Committee on Tax Reform met Monday, May 4, to examine and evaluate the current tax system and to determine if any changes are needed. As the committee moves forward with the first study of the state’s tax code in nine years, the all-day meeting focused on separate tax reform studies during both the Underwood and Manchin administrations. Discussion also concentrated on residential property tax rates, which are below most other states. Deputy Revenue Secretary Mark Muchow told the committee that residential property taxes average 20 percent nationwide, but only 5 percent in West Virginia. Delegate Eric Nelson, co-chair of the committee, says the goal of the committee is to ensure the state’s tax code is fair, simple and structure to promote economic growth. The committee is scheduled to meet again on Monday, May 18, with the meeting focusing on the recent changes that other states have made to their tax codes.

## **HOUSE APPROVES MILITARY CONSTRUCTION & VETERANS AFFAIRS FUNDING BILL**

Late last week, the House of Representatives passed a funding bill for military construction and the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) programs on a 255 to 163 vote. The Military Construction and Veterans Affairs appropriations bill increases military construction and family housing spending to \$7.7 billion, which is \$900 million over FY 2015 levels. The bill, however, falls below the \$8.4 billion president's budget request for those accounts in FY 2016. The House also approved an amendment to the bill that would prohibit the use of any funds to implement a new BRAC round. You can find project-specific funding information in the House Committee Report, [linked here](#). There is \$3.9 million in the budget for road relocation near the West Virginia National Guard headquarters at Coonskin Park in Charleston.

Lawmakers dealt a blow to the president's request for \$1.143 billion to fund the VA's major construction account—which funds projects above \$10 million—by providing just \$561 million, or 50 percent of that request, for FY 2016 funds. Congressional frustration with significant delays and cost overruns on major VA construction projects account for this action. The bill restricts the ability of the VA to move funds between construction accounts and requires increased VA construction reporting requirements concerning project scope changes.

Rep. Evan Jenkins, R-Third District, is a member of the House Appropriations Committee. He helped secure full funding for rural health programs for veterans in the bill. He also secured a provision to improve consideration of how far veterans live from VA facilities when the VA awards grants for veterans' transportation programs.

## **OSHA ISSUES CONFINED SPACES IN CONSTRUCTION FINAL RULE**

On Friday, May 1, the Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) issued its long-awaited confined spaces in construction standard. The new rule will cover activities on construction sites with one or more confined spaces such as manholes, crawl spaces, tanks and other confined spaces that are not intended for continuous occupancy with exemptions for work covered by the excavation and underground construction standards. The final rule is very similar to the general industry standard, but with some differences tailored to the construction industry. These differences include: controlling contractor requirements, continuous monitoring for hazards, and responsibilities of a competent person.

During the rulemaking process, AGC members recommended that the agency align the final rule with that of the general industry, as opposed to the proposal, which included a very confusing confined spaces classification system as well as other requirements that presented compliance challenges. The standard will become effective on August 3, 2015.

## **CORRIDOR H GROUP PUSHES FOR FIVE-YEAR COMPLETION**

Robbie Morris, executive director of the Randolph County Development Authority and chairman of the Robert C. Byrd Corridor H Authority, announced at a recent news conference that West Virginia can no longer wait decades for Corridor H to be completed. Through research and information provided by the WVDOH, they have found a way to complete the project by 2020. Morris declared that state and business leaders of the WVDOH agree that if a public-private partnership (P3) is approved in the next few months, Corridor H could be completed by the end of 2020. Entering into a P3 would involve making payments over time in order to complete the transportation project and will save WV taxpayers nearly \$200 million in construction costs. Funding issues have been continuously delayed, with years often passing between construction segments. The FHA regulations require the state to allow money to accumulate until enough is available to construct a usable segment of the highway. Currently there are 31 miles of Corridor H to be completed.

## **HOPE FADING ON HIGHWAY REAUTHORIZATION BILL BY MAY 31**

Congress has just weeks to provide options to reauthorize the federal-aid highway bill that expires May 31. It is expected some sort of highway funding extension will materialize before Congress recesses May 22, be it through July, September or the end of the year. As Republicans scramble to ensure that a shutdown of highway projects doesn't occur this summer, there is still no long-term infrastructure package that Congress and the White House can agree upon. "There'll be something done," Sen. John Thune, SD, the No. 3 Republican in the Senate, told reporters this week. "I'm not saying it's going to be the solution that we're all ultimately hoping will happen." The Highway Trust Fund is roughly \$16 billion short of the \$50 billion the federal government spends on roads in a given year. Transportation Secretary Anthony Foxx has said in recent weeks that the trust fund could make it into a least July, as long as highway policy is reauthorized by the end of the month. Foxx has said the Obama administration would accept a "purposeful" temporary extension, if lawmakers are serious about using the extra time to craft a broader infrastructure package. While some lawmakers have floated a gas tax hike, senior Republicans have ruled it out.

"Most everybody knows I'm sincere in trying to get this [highway reauthorization bill] done," said Senate Finance Committee Chairman Orrin Hatch, R-UT, one of the lawmakers charged with finding the revenue for construction projects. "We're so sick and tired of these doggone patches all the time. But there's no quick answer to it." Hatch, who has been holding meetings with his committee on infrastructure, and House Ways and Means Committee Chairman Paul Ryan, R-WI, are among the lawmakers who have proposed finding enough highway funding, about \$10 billion, to last through the end of the year. Sen. Chuck Grassley, R-IA, said Wednesday Hatch had found about half the offsets he needed for that sort of extension.

The construction industry continues to express concerns that Washington's inability to craft a long-term highway bill has made it difficult for state governments to plan construction projects.

## **WVDOH SPOKESMAN SAYS WORK ZONE SPEEDING AN 'EPIDEMIC'**

Speeding and distracted driving in highway work zones has become an “epidemic” according to state Division of Highways spokesman Brent Walker. “It’s not just in West Virginia but across the country. We’ve to get our arms around it,” Walker said Thursday. The DOH, working with West Virginia State Police and other law enforcement agencies, is planning stepped up enforcement in the work zones between now and September. Walker said there’s not a day that goes by that the DOH doesn’t learn of another close call in a work zone. “It’s just this simple—just slow down, that is all,” Walker said. “The difference between going the speed limit and slowing down is really a matter of seconds—20, 40 seconds—maybe a minute.” Walker said DOH workers and agency contractors deserve a safe place to work.

“For those folks whose offices are along the roadway—let them have some degree of safety, the expectation to work in a safe environment. Just slow down, get through the work zone and be on your way,” Walker said. The DOH publicized a couple of close calls early in the construction season including a situation in Jackson County where a crew was working on potholes when a tractor trailer came speeding through the I-77 work zone. The agency is expected to announce more information about its enforcement efforts next week.

## **DECISION PENDING ON SELECTION OF WVDOH AUDITING FIRM**

An announcement is expected soon on the selection of the firm that will be conducting an audit of the WVDOH. [H.B. 2008](#) was passed this legislative session that will require a full audit of the operations of the WVDOH, including the ten districts. House leaders said it is necessary to see how the division is spending its dollars before providing additional money. The audit, which can cost up to \$500,000, must be completed by December 31, 2015. The bill’s original completion date was February 2016. The CAWV expressed concern that the bill could delay action on funding next legislative session if the report was not complete until half-way through the 60-day session. The selection of the auditing firm will be made by the Legislative Auditor under the oversight of the Joint Committee on Government and Finance. Senate President Bill Cole told the CAWV yesterday the selection could be made as early as next week.

## **WHEELING SALES TAX FUNDS MORE THAN \$1M IN PAVING**

The total amount spent on paving for the year in Wheeling reached more than \$1 million after City Council approved the city’s latest paving contracts. Majority of the funds come from the city sales tax, which was enacted in 2013. Proceeds from the sales tax are set aside for four main purposes: infrastructure projects, upgrades to WesBanco Arena, funding police and fire pensions and replacing revenue lost when council lowered business and occupation taxes. City Council made it clear from the beginning that sales tax revenue would go back to residents in the form of infrastructure improvements. The city also uses Community Development Block Grant funds for paving, which can only be used in low to moderate-income areas or to improve accessibility at public facilities.
