VOTE, VOTE, VOTE! **ELECTION DAY - TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 6**

EARLY VOTING ENDS TOMORROW - ELECTION DAY NOVEMBER 6

The CAWV encourages members to vote. Election Day is Tuesday, November 6. Early Voting started October 24 and ends tomorrow, Saturday, November 3. West Virginians will have the chance to vote for numerous offices on the ballot including the United States Senate, the United States House of Representatives, half of the West Virginia State Senate, all one-hundred seats in the West Virginia House of Delegates, and various county and municipal offices. In addition, two unexpired seats on the West Virginia Supreme Court of Appeals are on the ballot. Justices Evan Jenkins and Tim Armstead were appointed earlier this fall to fill those vacancies and are both running in the election to complete the remainder of the terms. GOV. JUSTICE APPOINTS WHITE AS DIRECTOR OF MINERS' HEALTH, SAFETY AND TRAINING

Governor Justice has appointed Ernest Eugene White as director of West Virginia Miners' Health, Safety and Training (MHST). He fills the position being vacated by the retiring Greg Norman, who joined MHST in 2006. White joined MHST in 2007 as Inspector at Large for Region 3. He served in several leadership posts in the agency. In 2017, he was appointed MHST deputy director. A third-generation miner, White is a native of West Virginia. He has 45 years of coal mining experience, including work in underground coal mines after graduation from high school.

End of Daylight Savings

Early last Sunday morning, November 4th, most of those in the United States turned their clocks back one hour for the end of Daylight Saving Time. Most of us think: *“Fantastic! I get another hour of sleep”*; and yes you did. However, there is a huge difference between the “society clock” and the “biological clock” we all work from. During such time changes there is statistically an increase in safety incidents.

With the end of daylight savings time comes an increase of darkness around the time of rush hour, when traffic is at a peak and many are making our way home from work. Drivers aren't used to the decreased visibility – nor are construction workers, who might take chances crossing roads when they shouldn't.

The National Road Safety Foundation (NRSF) has done studies proving that auto accidents increase after the clocks fall back an hour. Besides the lack of visibility, the NRSF notes that commuting in the dark can also make drivers drowsier than usual. According to some health studies, changes in waking time coupled with the earlier onset of darkness throws off our internal clocks. This increases driving risks, primarily because in our 24/7 society, we have a fundamental problem of already being sleep deprived.

The end of daylight saving time can leave many feeling fatigued, which can pose safety risks both at home and in the workplace. Stay alert!

Safety professionals have long used the start and end of daylight saving time as reminders for performing recurring safety tasks. Use the occasion of setting your clocks back as a cue to:

- **Check and replace the batteries in your smoke and carbon monoxide (CO) alarms.** Ensure they are working properly and replace the batteries. As the cold sets in and many start up their gas-fired furnaces, fireplaces, portable unit heaters and the like for the first time, carbon monoxide poisoning risks increase dramatically during this time of year. Replace any smoke alarm unit that is older than 10 years.
- **Prepare a winter emergency kit for your automobile.** Such kits can be a lifesaver if you are stuck out in bad weather while driving. They should include items such as: warm clothes, blanket, flashlight, batteries, water, non-perishable snacks, shovel, flares, reflective hazard triangle, jumper cables, cat litter or sand for traction, ski hat and gloves.
- **Check to see if your fire extinguishers need recharging.** Check the small gauge at the top of the extinguisher. If the needle in that gauge is in the green, chances are, the extinguisher is okay. If it is in the red, you need to have the extinguisher recharged.

FHWA ANNOUNCES ENVIRONMENTAL RULE CHANGES

This week the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) released revised rules intended to streamline National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) review requirements and adjust other key environmental rules to speed up and ensure “greater consistency” in the permitting of surface transportation projects. The rule changes also allow the Federal Railroad Administration (FRA) to adopt the same procedures as the FHWA and to coordinate environmental reviews with the Federal Transit Administration (FTA). The revisions will ensure that state agencies can produce a single environmental document, as well as combine a final Environmental Impact Statement (EIS), EIS with a Record of Decision (ROD), or ROD document for any project. Another key provision allows projects that are within the highway right-of-way to use the far less onerous and cumbersome categorical exclusion (CE) provisions for the environmental review. AGC worked for the inclusion of these and other environmental streamlining provisions in both the Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century Act (MAP-21) and Fixing America’s Surface Transportation Act (FAST Act) transportation authorization bills. AGC also provided comments to FHWA in [January of 2017](#) and [November of 2017](#) as it proposed the rule changes over the past three years.

ARTBA NAMES NEW PRESIDENT & CEO

Dave Bauer has been named president and CEO of ARTBA, effective Jan. 1, 2019. He will succeed Pete Ruane, who retires Oct. 31, after 30 years of service, the longest leadership tenure in the association’s 116-year history. ARTBA Executive Vice President & Chief Operating Officer William D. Toohey, Jr., who has been with the association 34 years and had announced his intention to retire in April 2019, was appointed interim president and CEO by the board and will assist in the transition process. The ARTBA’s board of directors’ unanimous decision on Bauer was announced earlier this month at the association’s National Convention in New York City. Bauer joined ARTBA in 1997, and currently serves as its executive vice president of advocacy. Bauer, as head of ARTBA’s government relations team, has directed the association’s lobbying, grassroots initiatives, policy development, regulatory engagement, political fundraising and disbursements. He played a key leadership role in the passage of four major federal highway and public transit investment laws: TEA-21 (1998), SAFETEA-LU (2005), MAP-21 (2012) and the FAST Act (2015).

DECEMBER TEST DATES ANNOUNCED FOR ASPHALT FIELD AND COMPACTION TECHNICIAN RECERTIFICATION

The WVDOH has announced three testing dates for members needing recertified as Asphalt Field and Compaction Technicians (AFCT). Approximately 95 individuals have AFCT certifications that expire December 31, 2018. Members can begin registering for the recertification tests online next week. Testing opportunities will be offered at 8 A.M. and 1 P.M. on December 4, 5 and 6 at MCS&T Division in Charleston. These are the only dates and locations offered for renewals that expire in 2018. Certifications MUST be renewed prior to the expiration date or the full course and exam will be required. This is true for all technician certification programs, although AFCT is the only technician program that has certifications expiring in 2018.
