AGC CHAPTER LEADERS MEET IN WASHINGTON

AGC of America chapter leaders, including CAWV Senior Vice President Dan Flesher, Trimble Engineers and Constructors, Inc., Morgantown, joined chapter leaders in Washington, D.C. last week to discuss best practices and to meet with Congress to address AGC's top legislative issues. The annual AGC National and Chapter Leadership Conference included speakers from Capitol Hill and breakout sessions to discuss the industry's most pressing issues, including federal initiatives for infrastructure funding, multi-employer pension plan reform, environmental regulatory issues and immigration reform.

Speakers included Fox News' panelist Charles Krauthammer, a Pulitzer Prize-winning columnist and political commentator. Rep. John Delaney, D-MD, and Rep. Reid Ribble, R-WI, spoke about their efforts to develop a bi-partisan bill to provide funding for infrastructure investment, The Partnership to Build America Act. The chapter leaders also reviewed best practices for membership retention, state infrastructure initiatives, BIM and LEAN curriculum, and developing future construction workforces.

Sen. Joe Manchin, D-WV, was able to attend the President's Dinner held at Union Station. He met with AGC's leadership and provided members insight into the pending shut down of government services. He had to leave the dinner to go back to the Senate Floor for a late-night vote. CAWV and AGC were able to discuss with Sen. Manchin H.B. 2232, The Make Every Small Business Count Act. This legislation is essential to helping grow and enhance small business opportunities by adding an incentive for general contractors to consider small businesses for more subcontracts. The bill's simple record-keeping change – at no cost to the government – will encourage general contractors to provide opportunities for small businesses to compete for subcontracts at every tier.

Chairman Dan Cooperrider will be scheduling a meeting of the CAWV Legislative Committee to review prospective legislation for the 2014 Regular Session of the West Virginia Legislature. TAKE SAFETY INSPECTIONS AND AUDITS SERIOUSLY

One of the tools a company uses to keep updated on how their safety and health program is doing is to perform safety inspections and audits. Inspecting the work practices of employees and checking equipment to see that is still operating safely is just good common sense. Take the information generated as a result of safety inspections and make it work FOR you, not against you. Take safety inspections seriously. A safety inspection report can be a great tool to help a company grow and prosper, if it's used to make improvements.

Create greater trust among employees and provide the safest work environment possible. Take safety inspections and audits seriously.
