## **CAWV BOARD MEETS IN CONJUNCTION WITH FALL MEETING**

The CAWV Board of Directors held its meeting October 25 in conjunction with the CAWV Fall Meeting. It was held at Nemaquin Woodlands Resort with many members in North Central West Virginia attending. Board members discussed a number of issues, including the upcoming legislative session and proposals by the CAWV Education Committee to provide members with a number of educational opportunities. The committee plans to offer an ongoing, web-based curriculum to enhance job performance and advance careers in the construction industry. The Board also voted to support Simulated Workplace, a program by the WV Department of Education to provide environments for career and technical education students that will build strong workplace skills and ethics. Members will be asked to participate in Simulated Workplace with more information to follow. The Board also voted to accept two new contractor members and six new associate members, which are listed in this Newsletter.

"We had a very productive meeting and looked at a number of issues that will affect the CAWV and our membership in the coming months," said CAWV President Phil Weser, March-Westin Company. "It's obvious that our committees are working on programs and policies that will benefit contractor and associate members alike. It was also good to see a number of our members in the area join us for the reception, dinner and board meeting," he said.

## **CONSTRUCTION DOWN 11 PERCENT THROUGH SEPTEMBER**

McGraw Hill Construction reports that September contracts for future construction in West Virginia are down 20 percent from September 2012, \$155.5 million in 2012 versus \$125.0 million in 2013. Nonresidential construction was down 54 percent, from \$52.7 million in September 2012 to \$24.0 million in September 2013. Nonbuilding construction decreased 15 percent from \$80.9 million in September 2012 to \$69.1 million in September 2013. Nonbuilding construction includes roads, bridges, water and sewer facilities, dams and airports. Residential construction increased 46 percent, up from \$21.8 million in September 2012 to \$31.9 million in September 2013.

McGraw-Hill Construction provides the following totals on construction activity in West Virginia through September.

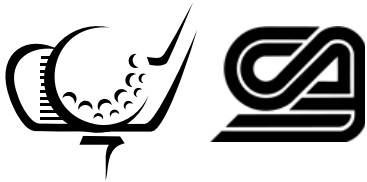

## **SBA DESIGN-BUILD MAIN TOPIC AT CAWV JOINT ARCHITECTS COMMITTEE MEETING**

The CAWV Joint Architects Committee met on October 29 at the CAWV Headquarters. Committee members discussed the two School Building Authority of West Virginia (SBA) design-build projects - Lumberport Middle School in Harrison County and Franklin Elementary School in Pendleton County. Members of the SBA Administration Office, SBA Board of Directors, Harrison and Pendleton County superintendents, and several design-build project teams discussed how the process could be improved moving forward. Recommendations included allowing more time for the criteria development stage, more time for the design-build teams to put together their bid package and making sure in-depth geotechnical reports are provided. One advantage of the design-build process is that the project should be finished sooner, but compressed timelines in current projects may have led to them coming in over budget. The SBA will continue to monitor the two projects during the construction phase to see if other issues need to be addressed.

"I really appreciate the input and cooperation of the Contractors Association of West Virginia and its members," said Dr. Mark Manchin, Executive Director of the SBA. "We will take the issues discussed and distribute a meeting recap to get input on how to move forward."

Committee members also received task force reports and a legislative update. In addition, Scott Raines, Director of Architectural Services for the School Building Authority (SBA) of West Virginia, discussed the SBA's bidding procedures and policy changes. These changes will be sent to CAWV Building Division members for review and comments. The CAWV / SBA Task Force will meet on November 19 at 9:00 a.m. at the CAWV offices to discuss the proposed changes and share member's comments with the SBA.

## Three Point Rule: Avoid Falls

Falling while getting into or out of truck cabs or heavy equipment or when mounting or dismounting truck bodies or trailers can cause serious injuries. Many knee, ankle and back injuries result from jumping from equipment onto uneven ground or objects. This becomes even more prevalent as the weather gets colder and ice forms on contact surfaces. The biggest cause of falls from a vehicle is human error and failure to follow the "Three Point Rule". The Three Point Rule requires three of four points of contact to be maintained with the vehicle at all times – two hands and one foot, or both feet and one hand. This system allows maximum stability and support, reducing the likelihood of slipping and falling. There are important steps that can be taking to prevent mounting/dismounting injuries with use of the Three Point Rule being most important.

### WHAT THE EMPLOYER CAN DO:

- Evaluate every truck and piece of equipment.
- Provide additional steps, non-slip surfaces and hand holds where necessary.
- Maintain steps, contact surfaces and handholds in useable condition. Inspect frequently.
- Instruct all workers in safely mounting and dismounting equipment, including the 3-point contact method.
- Install warning decals or signs in the cab or on the door of trucks and heavy equipment reminding workers to use 3-point contact.

### WHAT THE EMPLOYEE CAN DO:

- Keep steps, ladders and standing surfaces free of snow, mud and debris. Report damage immediately.
- Don't use tires or wheel hubs as a step surface.
- Don't use the doorframe or door edge as a handhold.
- Wear footwear with good support and slip resistance.
- Don't climb down with something in your hand. Leave it on the vehicle floor and retrieve it after getting safely on the ground.
- Don't rush to climb out after a long shift.
- Descend slowly to avoid straining a muscle.
- Be extra careful when working in inclement weather.
- Exit and enter facing the cab.
- Get a firm grip on rails or handles.
- Never Jump! You may land on an uneven surface, off balance or on something. Look before exiting.
