FIRST CAWV LEGISLATIVE BULLETIN SENT JANUARY 13

Members should have received, via e-mail, the first CAWV Legislative Bulletin of the session on Monday, January 13. [H.B. 4168](#), the House version of the Buy American, is expected to be on Wednesday's agenda of the House Industry and Labor Committee meeting. The OSHA 10-Hour bill, [S.B. 376](#), was introduced today in the Senate. It will require all employees on a construction project to complete the 10-hour OSHA bill. It has a single reference to the Senate Labor Committee. A number of bills affecting the purchasing of products and services have been introduced, including [S.B. 358](#) which requires the director of purchasing to approve change orders above a certain limit. CAWV SAFETY AWARD PROGRAM ACCEPTING ENTRIES

Each year, the CAWV Safety Committee invites members of the association to participate in the Safety Award Program. Awards are presented at EXPO in March to companies who have exhibited excellence in safety at the workplace. Members participating in the program are scored on their documented safety policies and procedures, their commitment and approach to safety and health, as well as their recorded statistical data for the year. Special attention is given to the quality of safety training provided to employees and to companies who demand active employee involvement in their safety process. Finalists are chosen from contractors and associates who achieve an excellent performance rating. Awards are presented in the following categories: Building Division, Utility Division, Industrial Division, Specialty Contractor Division and Associate Division.

Winners in each category will receive a plaque and 85 award points that can be redeemed for items such as hats, jackets, shirts, travel mugs, golf shirts and a vehicle safety kit. BUILDING 3 RENOVATIONS AT CAPITOL BACK ON TRACK

The long-delayed renovation of Building 3 in the Capitol Complex is back on track and expected to bid later this year. Opened in 1951, and informally known as the DMV building, the eight-story Building 3 was originally approved for renovation in 2008, with a 2010 completion date. The project was delayed, first when it took much longer than expected to relocate state employees housed in Building 3, and again in 2011, when bids for the renovations came in about \$6 million higher than the \$27 million budgeted. The Department of Administration has been working with architects and planners to scale back the design, which originally included conference rooms with "telepresence" technology featuring floor-to-ceiling video screens, along with a meeting hall and kitchen capable of hosting dinners and receptions.

The workers are naturally reluctant to get started on bitterly cold days. The major difference between the two, related to the cold weather, is that the equipment has no side effects from the cold once it does get started. Our people, on the other hand can suffer a number of hazards associated with winter weather.

Slippery conditions can be present at the start of the day that were not even considered as a hazard the day before. It is wise to look at the job site each morning to see where conditions may create a slip and fall hazard. Then take a few moments to salt or sand the area where people will be walking, i.e., from the parking area, to the office trailer, up the steps and into the change trailers. **Have a safety person and field supervisors check any elevated work platforms, ladders, pipe racks and floors and structural steel BEFORE sending workers out to their assignments.** Use a heat source to effectively remove ice and snow from areas if safely possible. (Don't forget to obtain a proper "hot work" permit where required).

Equipment operators and truck drivers need to be cautioned to clean off the steps to their cabs. If access to other parts of the equipment is necessary for maintenance, fueling, loading and unloading, they too need to be cleaned of ice and snow.

Dressing to meet the cold conditions is extremely important. Staying comfortable in cold weather is not an easy task. Every worker will approach his level of comfort by wearing varied layers of clothing. It is important for the more experienced worker to mentor less experienced co-workers to give them pointers on how to keep their feet warm and how dress to keep exposed skin to a minimum.

Being properly clothed and taking the time to eliminate slippery conditions on the job site is proven to go a long way to improve production and reduce the possibility of someone getting hurt. This proactive approach to managing risks will produce positive results.

Lastly, be especially careful on your trip to and from work. Get to work and arrive home safely. Be aware of areas on the highway where there may be icy patches, approach bridges with the expectation that ice may have formed on them.

FY 2014 TRANSPORTATION INVESTMENT LEVELS RELEASED

The House and Senate Appropriations committees released the details of a government-wide spending measure to fund all federal discretionary programs for the remainder of FY 2014. As expected, the final agreement adheres to the highway and public transportation investment commitments established in the 2012 Moving Ahead for Progress in the 21st Century surface transportation law. The final bill would provide:

- \$40.3 billion for highway investment (a \$600 million increase from FY 2013)
- \$10.7 billion for public transportation (a \$100 million increase from FY 2013)
- \$3.35 billion for the Airport Improvement Program (the same as FY 2013)
- \$1 billion for Amtrak capital and debt service grants
- \$600 million for the U.S. Department of Transportation's TIGER grant program which supports intermodal transportation projects

The House and Senate are expected to act on the FY 2014 funding measure this week. While the bill is helpful in finalizing transportation investment for the rest of the year, it represents the last installment of MAP-21's temporary Highway Trust Fund revenue patch. Absent remedial action, the Congressional Budget Office projects trust fund revenues will not be able to support any new highway or public transportation investment in FY 2015.

HOUSE KICKS OFF 2014 SURFACE TRANSPORTATION REAUTHORIZATION

The House Transportation and Infrastructure (T&I) Committee heard testimony from private and public sector representatives, all of whom called for enactment of a long-term, sustainable surface transportation reauthorization bill this year. T&I Committee Chairman Bill Shuster (R-Pa.) began the hearing by stating his intention to have a surface transportation bill passed by the House before August. Shuster also laid out the following key principles for the new legislation: funded in a fiscally responsible manner; build on reforms made in MAP-21; reduce regulatory burdens; enhance flexibility for states and locals; and focus on freight mobility.

Governor Mary Fallin (R-Okla), chair of the National Governors Association (NGA), told committee members that "Infrastructure requires an intergovernmental partnership—and all levels of government have a crucial role to play." Fallin emphasized this point by declaring "governors agree that successful state action does not justify federal disengagement."

Caterpillar Group President and ARTBA Board Member Stu Levenick repeatedly backed up the governor's call for a strong federal-state-local partnership, saying, "While its admirable states are taking the initiative to do this, if we wind up with a patchwork of 50 different states and you haven't created a national network that's very efficient.
