TANK LEAK LEADS TO REGULATORY LEGISLATION; OSHA 10-HOUR PASSES COMMITTEE

The tank leak that caused a nine-county region to go without water for over a week has spawned numerous bills to regulate above ground storage tanks. Gov. Earl Ray Tomblin held a press conference this week to introduce his bill, [S.B. 417](#), which gives the WV Department of Environmental Protection the authority to regulate the construction and maintenance of above ground tanks. In addition, the bill requires water utilities to have contingency plans for emergencies. Sen. John Unger, D-Berkeley, introduced last week [S.B. 373](#), which covers the regulation of a number of tanks. The Senate Natural Resources Committee Monday combined many of the elements in both bills into one. The Senate Judiciary Committee yesterday further amended the bill and sent it to the Senate floor with a recommendation for passage. The CAWV reviewed the governor's bill to see if tanks associated with contractors' and suppliers' fixed and temporary construction-related tanks fall under the original bill's exemptions since many of CAWV members' tanks are regulated and inspected on a regular basis. The current bill is under review to see what, if any, additional regulatory requirements are anticipated.

Also this week, the Senate Labor Committee passed [S.B. 376](#), the OSHA 10-Hour safety program bill. The state Building Trades, major supporters of the bill, filled the committee room to listen to the proceedings. S.B. 376 requires every worker on a public construction contract to complete the OSHA 10-Hour training program. The bill now goes to the Senate Judiciary Committee. [S.B. 334](#), introduced by Governor Tomblin, diverts \$13 million a year for two years from the State Road Fund to the state's general fund. [S.B. 385](#) diverts \$20 million a year for three years from the West Virginia Infrastructure Fund to the general fund. Both bills are aimed at shoring up the projected \$125 million shortfall in the Fiscal Year 2015 state budget. A subcommittee of the Senate Transportation and Infrastructure Committee met Thursday to discuss the highway diversion bill. AGC OF AMERICA RELEASES 2014 CONSTRUCTION HIRING AND BUSINESS OUTLOOK

AGC of America released its 2014 Construction Hiring and Business Outlook, Tuesday, January 21. Based on responses received from over 800 member firms who answered a series of survey questions about hiring expectations, business, cost, and regulatory issues in 2014, most contractors predict demand will either grow or remain stable in virtually every market segment this year. "Contractors are more optimistic about 2014 than they have been in a long time," said Stephen E. Sandherr, the association's chief executive officer. "While the industry has a long way to go before it returns to the employment and activity levels it experienced in the middle of the last decade, conditions are heading in the right direction."

Among public sector segments, contractors are more optimistic about demand for new water and sewer construction, with a net positive of 17 percent. Contractors are mildly optimistic about the market for highway construction, with a net positive of 10 percent. Respondents are almost equally divided regarding the outlook for the other four segments, ranging from net positives of 5 percent for public buildings, 4 percent for schools, 3 percent for transportation facilities other than highways, to a negative of 2 percent for marine construction. 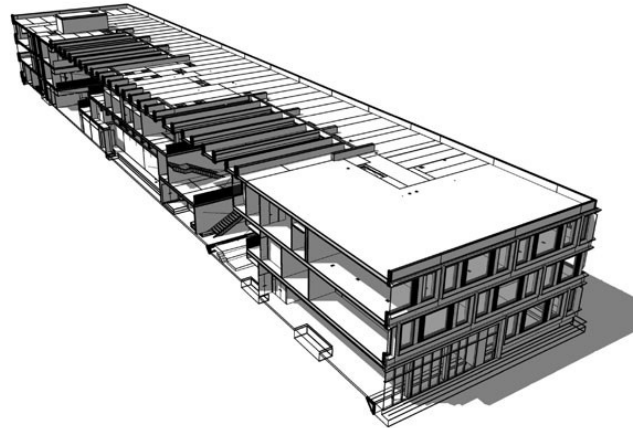

SBA COMES THROUGH WITH PROMISE FOR NEW IAEGER ELEMENTARY

The state School Building Authority approved final funding Thursday for a 10-year, five-school deal, in McDowell County. In 2004, the SBA set aside \$100 million as part of a long-term school system improvement plan with the federal government and U.S. Army Corp of Engineers that went toward construction of much needed, new buildings. Because 10 years have passed, the new laeger Elementary is going to cost a little bit more than they planned for in 2004.

“That simply reflects inflation as well as some additional square footage and some safety that we now require in every school built in the state of West Virginia,” according to SBA Executive Director Mark Manchin. That money was not taken out of the current SBA fund. Manchin said the members knew back in 2008 this last project was going to need a few million in extra cash, so they planned ahead. Since 2008, the SBA has put aside \$8 million in that fund. \$7.05 million goes toward laeger Elementary.
