GOVERNOR CALLS SPECIAL SESSION TO ADDRESS WAGE BILL, BUDGET ISSUES

Gov. Earl Ray Tomblin says he plans to call a special session of the Legislature to correct problems with the minimum wage bill and to address issues with the 2015 fiscal year budget. The session is expected to be in conjunction with the May legislative interim meetings. H.B. 4283, which increases the state's minimum wage incrementally, from \$7.25 per hour to \$8 per hour on January 1, 2015 and to \$8.75 on January 1, 2016, contained an unintended consequence. As it is currently drafted, the bill prevents West Virginia employers from relying on certain existing overtime exemptions under the Fair Labor Standards Act. The business community, municipal and county governments, higher education institutions and others stated that previously exempt workers will become subject to overtime and maximum hours provisions. Cities and counties alone stated their fire and police budgets would increase hundreds of thousands of dollars. They recommended the governor veto the bill to eliminate the overtime language. Joining Gov. Tomblin in the bill's signing were Senate President Jeff Kessler and House Speaker Tim Miley. They all pledged to preserve the federal exemptions and overtime provisions when the bill is brought up during the special session.

State revenues continue to lag behind estimates. With one quarter left in this fiscal year, the state has a \$78 million shortfall in revenues. While personal income tax collections are up, sales taxes are falling behind. (See this week's Highway Bulletin for State Road Fund revenues). Also, the tax credit which was applied to flex fuel vehicles continues to mount and tax officials won't know until after the April 15 tax returns come in what the total cost will be. Legislators rescinded the tax credit when it was determined it was costing the state general fund tens of millions of dollars. The governor performed a line item veto on the budget bill, trimming \$67 million from the budget approved by legislators following this year's legislative session. The governor has pledged to restore some of the cuts which will have to be addressed in the May special session.

The governor signed 203 bills, including S.B. 373, the bill relating to water resource protection and the regulation of above-ground storage tanks. He vetoed eight bills.

CONSTRUCTION UP 29 PERCENT THROUGH FEBRUARY

Contracts for future construction in West Virginia in February 2014 were up 25 percent from February 2013, \$162 million in 2014 versus \$129 million in 2013. Nonresidential construction experienced the largest boost, from \$75 million in February 2013 to \$108 million in February 2014. Nonbuilding construction was up 37 percent from \$27 million in February 2013 to \$37 million in February 2014. Nonbuilding construction includes roads, bridges, water and sewer facilities, dams and airports. Residential construction was down 39 percent, from \$27 million in February 2013 to \$16 million in February 2014.

WEST VIRGINIA'S CONSTRUCTION EMPLOYMENT HAD HIGHEST PERCENTAGE DECLINE IN A YEAR PERIOD

Construction firms added job in 37 states between February 2013 and February 2014, according to an analysis by the AGC of America of U.S. Labor Department data. Unfortunately, West Virginia had the highest percentage decline in construction employment, ranking the state 51 out of 50 states and the District of Columbia. In February 2013, 35,200 were employed in the construction industry in West Virginia. In February 2014, the number is 32,900, a 6.5% reduction. This puts West Virginia with the highest percentage decline, followed by District of Columbia (-5.0 percent, -700 jobs); Montana (-2.9 percent, -700 jobs); Indiana (-2.6 percent, -3,300 jobs) and New Hampshire (-2.2 percent, -500 jobs). The CAWV has communicated with legislators and the press that the lack of investment in infrastructure projects has a direct impact on construction employment. Funding for highways, bridges, schools and water and sewer systems creates jobs and economic development. The latest U.S. Labor Department figures provide an excellent argument why additional funding is needed for highway and other infrastructure programs.

The webinar entitled 'Reasonable Suspicion Testing for Drug and Alcohol Abuse' was presented by Randy Pauley, Administrator of Employee Screening Programs, Health Research Systems, (HRS). Mr. Pauley was a police officer prior to 2001 when he began working with drug testing programs. He credited his experience as a police officer in elevating his awareness of how important it is to make sure your workforce is drug and alcohol free. Mr. Pauley did an excellent presentation and emphasized that companies must make sure employees are knowledgeable of the drug testing policy they have in place. Safe Lifting

Most of us are aware that there is a right and a wrong way to lift something. Each year training is provided to make you aware of safe lifting techniques, however, did you know that an average of 30 people injure their backs on the job each day in one state alone. There are various types of injuries that can occur from lifting incorrectly. Back strain is a more common type of lifting injury. It results from the over stretching of certain muscles and can be avoided by employing correct lifting techniques and asking for help when having to move something heavy and/or awkward.

The "Do's" of Lifting

Is lifting part of your job routine? If so, then everyday you risk injury from strains, sprains, hernias, cuts, and bruises. Let's review the dos of lifting.

- Before you begin, know the right way to do the job.
- Check with your supervisor or co-worker if you have any questions about moving a load.
- Always size up the load.
- Get help for heavy or bulky objects. Inspect your path of travel.
- Be aware of stairs and tripping or slipping hazards.
- Choose the safest route.
- Be sure of a safe, firm grip.
- Check for sharp edges.
- If the load is wet or slippery, wipe it off.
- Lift with your legs, not your back.
- Squat down close to the load; keep your back straight; lift slowly with leg power.
- Use material handling equipment whenever possible. When properly used it can save a lot of manual effort.

The "Don'ts" of Lifting

- Avoid heavy, manual jobs if you have had previous back injuries, are underweight or overweight, or have a special medical problem such as a weak heart or high blood pressure.
- Never lift more than you can easily handle.
- Never lift with a rounded back and straight legs.
- Avoid twisting your body when lifting or carrying.
- Move your feet to change direction.
- Never lift from an unbalanced position. This means no lifting from one knee or reaching over another object to lift.
- Never carry a load that blocks your view ahead.

BOXER, VITTER AGREE ON HIGHWAY BILL FRAMEWORK, SEEK MODEST FUNDING HIKE

Senate Environment and Public Works Committee Chairperson Barbara Boxer (D-Calif) and other committee leaders have reached an agreement on an outline for the highway-policy portion of a hoped-for new surface-transportation measure. A key element of the framework, which Boxer and her colleagues announced April 10 at a press conference, is to set highway funding at current levels plus an increase to account for annual inflation. Boxer said that would require a \$16-billion-a-year increase over present revenue amounts that flow into the Highway Trust Fund. Boxer said the lawmakers want a long-term measure, which could be as long as six years. There is nearly universal agreement that the key question underlying the envisioned new bill is where to find that \$16 billion a year.

The lawmakers who signed on to the agreement are Environment and Public Works' "Big Four" on highway issues. Besides Boxer, they are David Vitter (R-La.), the committee's top Republican; Thomas Carper D-Del.), transportation and infrastructure subcommittee chairman; and John Barrasso (Wyo.), that subcommittee's leading GOP member. Vitter told reporters that he and the other senators expect to have the bill ready for committee action after they return from the two-week Easter-Passover break, which ends on April 28. Vitter also said the goal is to have the Senate act on the package by July or August, when the trust fund's highway account is projected to fall into a deficit position. Another deadline is Sept. 30, when MAP-21 expires.

In the House, Transportation and Infrastructure Committee Chairman Bill Shuster (R-Pa.) has said he hopes to have his panel vote on a highway and transit policy bill in spring or summer. Boxer said other principles in the Big Four's outline include provisions to "expand opportunities" for rural regions; continue to "leverage local resources to accelerate the construction of transportation projects"; and require "better information-sharing regarding federal grants." Vitter said the expanded role for states would be reflected "in a number of important areas that give localities and states more flexibility." U.S. Transportation Secretary Anthony Foxx has said the Obama administration also plans to propose a surface-transportation bill soon.
