GOOD PARTICIPATION FOR JUNE 11 CAWV CONGRESSIONAL FLY-IN

President Phil Weser will lead a large delegation of CAWV members at this year's CAWV Congressional Fly-In to Washington on June 11. This is the 26th year CAWV members have trekked to the Nation's Capital to meet with West Virginia's leaders to address issues affecting CAWV members and the contracting industry. High on this year's priority list will be the need to invest in the nation's infrastructure, particularly the reauthorization of the federal-aid highway bill. Highway contractors are being told now to prepare for slowdown of payments in August and September due to the Highway Trust Fund running out of funds (see this week's Highway Bulletin for complete details). APRIL 22 LAST DAY TO REGISTER TO VOTE IN WV'S PRIMARY ELECTION

Please be advised that April 22 is the last day to register to vote in West Virginia's Primary Election set for Tuesday, May 13 and early voting begins in less than two weeks, April 30. Early voting will extend this year through Saturday, May 30, during regular business hours at each county courthouse or annex, including Saturdays from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. The deadline for citizens to register to vote, change their address, or switch political parties is twenty-one (21) days before the election, or April 22. GOVERNOR TOMBLIN PROCLAIMS APRIL AS NATIONAL SAFE DIGGING MONTH

Gov. Earl Ray Tomblin proclaims April as National Safe Digging month and encourages West Virginians to call 811 before every digging project. "The depth of utility lines can vary and the risk of striking an underground utility exists-whether you're landscaping your yard or excavating a hillside," Gov. Tomblin said. "I have proclaimed April as National Safe Digging Month in an effort to raise awareness of the importance of calling West Virginia 811 before every digging project-large or small."

Every year, the nation's underground utility infrastructure is jeopardized and utility service is interrupted by unintentional damage caused by failure to dial 811 before starting a digging project. Striking a single pipeline, wire or cable can cause service disruptions or serious personal injury and may result in costly repairs or fines.

Miss Utility of West Virginia, Inc. (West Virginia 811), the statewide one call system, receives calls from homeowners and contractors regarding proposed digging projects. West Virginia 811 then notifies the appropriate utility companies so they can send out professional locators to the proposed digging site to mark the approximate location of underground utilities with flags and paint. SEN. ROCKEFELLER SECURES TAX MEASURE TO BENEFIT WV INFRASTRUCTURE

U.S. Sen. Jay Rockefeller, D-W.Va., secured a tax measure he believes will strengthen the infrastructure of the Mountain State. Sen. Rockefeller, along with U.S. Sens. Sherrod Brown, D-Ohio and Ben Cardin, D-Md., secured a provision in the U.S. Senate Finance Committee that would make it easier for schools to meet the private dollar match required by school construction bonds. "With a small change to our school bonds, we can make sure more schools districts across the country are able to pay for badly-needed renovations to school buildings," Sen. Rockefeller said. "If we aren't doing all we can to give our kids the best learning environment possible, we aren't doing our job."

The amendment calls for lowering the private match requirement from 10 percent to 5 percent. The higher matching requirement has been, according to Sen. Rockefeller, a major obstacle for small and rural school districts. "We've seen these bonds put to good use in West Virginia's schools to make them safer, put in up-to-date heating and air conditioning systems, and add performing arts centers," he said. "I'm glad this provision will help strengthen this already terrific program, and allow more schools to use every available dollar of these bonds."

Sen. Rockefeller has been pushing for new school construction investments since 2002 when he first introduced the America's Better Classrooms (ABC) Act. He also worked to include key school construction provisions in the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act in 2009. Most recently, Rockefeller introduced the Rebuilding America's Schools Act, which aims to strengthen and expand school construction bond programs in order to encourage school rehabilitation and construction.

April is National Safe Digging Month

This April marks the seventh annual National Safe Digging Month, WVUCA is reminding contractors to always contact Miss Utility of West Virginia before beginning any digging project. National Safe Digging Month is formally recognized by the U.S. House of Representatives and Senate and has traditionally earned the support from more than 40 state governors across the country.

When calling 811 (or 1-800-245-4848), contractors are connected to Miss Utility of West Virginia, the local one-call center, which notifies the appropriate utility companies of their intent to dig. Locate tickets can also be submitted electronically through www.muwv.org. Professional locators are then sent to the requested digging site to mark the approximate locations of underground lines with flags, paint or both.

A utility line is damaged by digging once every three minutes nationwide, and one-third of these incidents are caused by failure of the professional excavator or homeowner to call 811 before beginning their digging project.

The Common Ground Alliance's (CGA) 1,400 members have proclaimed April as National Safe Digging Month as a way to bring extra attention to the issue and reduce the risk of unnecessary infrastructure damage.

As part of National Safe Digging Month, CGA and WVUCA encourages homeowners and contractors to take the following steps when planning a digging project this spring:

1. Always call 811 a few days before digging, regardless of the depth or familiarity with the property.
2. Plan ahead. Call on Monday or Tuesday for work planned for an upcoming weekend, providing ample time for the approximate location of lines to be marked.
3. Confirm with your local one call center that all lines have been marked.
4. Learn what the various colors of paint and flags represent at www.call811.com/faqs.
5. Consider moving the location of your project if it is near utility line markings.
6. Don't allow work to begin if the lines aren't marked.

U.S. OSM HALTS AML-FUNDED WATERLINE PROJECTS UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE

The WV Office of Abandoned Mine Lands and Reclamation (AML) has been notified by the U.S. Office of Surface Mining that the federal agency has eligibility concerns with waterline projects currently under consideration for AML funding. In a letter to various project owners, Robert Rice, AML chief, writes, "As you know, AML waterline projects are initiated with feasibility studies for the purpose of determining the amount of AML funding eligible for a particular project. It is of great concern that OSM has notified AML of multiple eligibility inconsistencies with regards to the methods used to determine the percentage of impact caused by pre-law mining to groundwater sources with AML feasibility study areas. Because AML waterline projects are funded with federal dollars, OSM has the authority to deny AML's request to fund waterlines when a project has not satisfied AML eligibility requirements outlined in the Surface Mining Control and Reclamation Act of 1977 (SMCRA). Regrettably, we must advise you to cease further expenditures associated with the development of the AML-funded waterline projects until further notice. Should you continue to procure services for the development of

AML waterline projects, fees associated with project development may not be eligible for AML payment," he wrote.

OSM's order affects all AML waterline projects in design, and perhaps the \$18.8 million Hudson to Stateline project in Preston County that bid March 20. The project may need to show how it justifies receiving AML funding even though it was approved previously. Projects in Kanawha County that are in the design phase are now also on hold.

Chief Rice ended his letter adding, "Be assured that as OSM provides specifics related to each feasibility study, the AML program will work with your [public service districts/Regional Development Authorities] and consultant in an attempt to provide additional supporting eligibility justification to OSM. We understand the amount of time and resources that have been dedicated to the development of your project(s) and will work diligently with all involved to provide citizens impacted by the pre-law coal mining with safe and reliable drinking water."

The offices of Senator Joe Manchin and Rep. Shelley Moore Capito have been in contact with OSM officials to determine the future status of the projects and how soon the reviews can be conducted. The CAWV is meeting with AML officials next week and this will be a topic of discussion as well. More information will be in future Municipal-Utilities Bulletins.

US DOT UPDATES HIGHWAY TRUST FUND TICKER - AUGUST SHORTFALL PREDICTED

This week, the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT) updated their Highway Trust Fund Ticker, where they continue to project a shortfall before the end of August. US DOT estimates that the balance will dip to \$5 billion in June and could dip below \$4 billion in July, possibly forcing them to delay payments to states for highway and transit projects.

The coming weeks and months are critical in determining whether Congress provides a short- or long-term fix for the Highway Trust Fund. Through the Hardhats for Highways campaign, AGC and ARTBA are asking members of Congress to fix Highway Trust Fund and provide the revenue necessary to for a robust multi-year reauthorization of the federal transportation funding bill, MAP-21.

In a related issue, the Congressional Budget Office (CBO) said that the Department of Transportation's Highway Trust Fund will not have enough money under President Obama's proposed 2015 budget, despite an infusion of cash that has been suggested by the president. Obama has called for Congress to approve a four-year, \$302 billion surface transportation bill before the federal government's current road and transit funding measure expires in September. The money would be used to plug a hole in the Highway Trust Fund, which is normally used to pay for federal transportation projects. But the CBO said Thursday that Obama's budget would still leave the Highway Trust Fund with a shortfall because the Transportation Department needs to have at least \$4 billion in the account to keep pace with infrastructure obligations. The CBO has said previously that the Highway Trust Fund will go bankrupt as early as August without congressional action. The budgetary analysis agency has said it will take an extra \$100 billion in addition to the approximately \$34 billion per year that is expected to be brought in by the gas tax.

AGC AND ARTBA LEADERS HEAR FROM U.S. DOT SECRETARY

Highway and Transportation Division leaders from AGC and ARTBA hosted United States Department of Transportation Secretary Anthony Foxx on a conference call to hear an outline of the administration's soon-to-be-released surface transportation reauthorization proposal. Secretary Foxx is in the midst of a week-long bus tour across eight states where he is trying to build support for the administration's proposal and bring attention to the looming Highway Trust Fund insolvency. During the call, AGC and ARTBA leaders had the opportunity to ask questions of Secretary Foxx on issues ranging from DOT's proposed rule on the Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) program to why the administration's proposal places a significant increase on high-speed rail and Amtrak. Division leaders made it clear that AGC and ARTBA support a growing revenue source for the Highway Trust Fund that will provide continuity in the program and allow for a multiyear reauthorization of MAP-21.

WV QUARRY RULES TO BE FINALIZED AND INTRODUCED IN LEGISLATIVE SESSION

The task force between WV Crushed Aggregates Council and WV Miners' Health Safety and Training will meet Friday, April 25, at 8:00 a.m. at J.F. Allen Company's office in Buckhannon. The task force will finalize WVMHS&T rules for quarry operations and prepare them for the upcoming legislative session. The task force was created last year and worked for months to revise the quarry rules. Many WVCAC members have been involved in the rewrite.

"I thank all the members who spent countless hours meeting and discussing the current rules," said WVCAC Chairman Doug Canterbury, Boxley. "I also appreciate the work of WVMHS&T officials. They were very receptive to the concerns raised by the membership. Many of the rules quarry operators work under are outdated and no longer relevant to today's operations, both above and below ground. We think the new rules will be clear and easy to understand, making it easier for operators to comply with," the chairman said. "All of your hard work and commitment has produced a product that we can all be proud of," stated William Tucker, WVMHS&T administrator.

The rules must be submitted to the legislature in June or July in order for them to be acted upon by legislators during the 2015 session.
