## **CONGRESS PASSES HIGHWAY TRUST FUND PATCH**

Just hours after the House turned down the Senate's highway funding bill, Congress has passed a \$10.8 billion bill to fund the Highway Trust Fund. Without the temporary patch, the HTF would have run dry this month. The bill is expected to be signed by President Obama and should allow for continued funding for road, highway and bridge construction through May 2015. The Senate, by a vote of 81-13, agreed to drop support for its amended version of HR 5021 after the House earlier in the day voted to reject the Senate amendment. The Senate version would have reduced the amount of the transfer by \$3 billion and set December 19, 2014 as the authorization deadline. The final bill transfers \$10.8 billion into the Highway Trust Fund, allowing the trust fund to support an extension of MAP-21 authorization for the highway and transit programs through May 31, 2015. This transfer was necessary to ensure that the trust fund could meet its funding obligations for the duration of the extension.

In a MetroNews interview today, CAWV Executive Director Mike Clowser commended West Virginia's congressional delegation for taking action to continue funding with a short-term revenue patch. He noted that contractors will not be laying off construction workers during the height of the construction seasons. "We want to be clear, however, that this in no way solves West Virginia's or the nation's future highway transportation needs," Clowser told MetroNews News Director Jeff Jenkins. "Without a multi-year deal West Virginia and other states are going to be right back in the same situation we are today. They are going to be hesitant to start major road programs fearing funding will run out before they complete the project."

The CAWV also says it's time for state leaders to address the state Road Fund. "It's incumbent for Congress and the West Virginia Legislature to now focus on enacting long-term, sustainable revenue for the West Virginia's road, highway and bridge program," Clowser stated. ## **BIPARTISAN LEGISLATION TO SIMPLIFY COMPLIANCE WITH THE ACA INTRODUCED**

The Affordable Care Act (ACA) has different definitions of what constitutes a seasonal employee or worker when determining the size of an employer and whether an employer must offer insurance to those employees. This week, the House introduced bipartisan legislation that will eliminate the seasonal worker exemption from the ACA regulations, and instead marry the "seasonal worker" and "seasonal employee" definitions into one, clear definition. It would also exclude workers from the "applicable large employer" calculation who work for less than six months, while also excluding them from the requirement to offer coverage. The bill would be helpful to certain construction employers that utilize seasonal workforces. AGC joined over 100 employer associations in a letter supporting the legislation and will continue to monitor its progress.

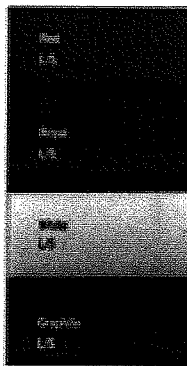

## **AGC-SUPPORTED DESIGN-BUILD REFORM BILL INTRODUCED IN SENATE**

On July 24, Sen. Deb Fischer (R-Neb.) introduced S. 2652, a bill that would reasonably limit one-step design-build procurements and the shortlist for two-step design-build procurements. Specifically, the bill would mandate the use of the two-step design-build procurement process for projects valued at \$750,000 or more. As a result, there would be no one-step design-build procurements above this threshold, though they would be allowed below that. Additionally, the bill would require contracting officers to provide written justification for short listing more than five finalists in the two-step design build process. Having more than five, ten and even twenty teams submit full technical proposals on design-build solicitations is incredibly costly and inherently risky. Federal agencies continued packing the short list or use of one-step design-build solicitations on mega-projects serves to drive away contractor and designer teams, thereby eliminating a substantial amount of competition.

AGC testified in support of a similar measure before a House committee late last year. The introduction of S. 2652 comes as a result of AGC's coalition efforts pushing a host of procurement reforms, which also include prohibiting reverse auctions for construction services, and increasing the Small Business Administration's (SBA) loan guarantee to allow more small businesses access to SBA loans. The CAWV is contacting Senators Jay Rockefeller and Joe Manchin to cosponsor and support S. 2652.

## OSHA INSPECTIONS - PART I

The Occupational Safety and Health Administration is committed to strong, fair and effective enforcement of safety and health requirements in the workplace. OSHA inspectors are experienced, well-trained industrial hygienists and safety professionals whose goal is to assure compliance with OSHA requirements and help employers and workers reduce on-the-job hazards and prevent injuries, illnesses and death in the workplace.

### Inspection Priorities

OSHA cannot inspect all seven million workplaces it covers each year. The agency seeks to focus its inspection resources on the most hazardous workplaces in the following order of priority.

1. Imminent Danger Situations-Hazards that could cause death or serious physical harm receive top priority. OSHA inspectors will ask employers to correct these hazards immediately or remove endangered employees.
2. Fatalities and Catastrophes-Incidents that involve a death or hospitalization of three or more employees come next. Employers must report such catastrophes to OSHA within eight hours.
3. Complaints-Allegations of hazards or violations also receive a high priority. Employees may request anonymity when they file complaints.
4. Referrals of hazard information from other federal, state or local agencies, individuals, organizations or the media service consideration for inspection.
5. Follow-ups-Checks for abatement of violations cited during previous inspections are also conducted by the agency in certain circumstances.
6. Planned or Programmed Investigations-Inspections aimed at specific high-hazard industries or individual workplaces that have experienced high rates of injuries and illnesses also receive priority.

### Phone/Fax Investigations

OSHA carefully prioritizes all complaints it receives based on their severity. For lower-priority hazards, with permission of a complainant, OSHA may telephone the employer to describe safety and health concerns, following up with a fax providing details on alleged safety and health hazards. The employer must respond in writing within five working days, identifying any problems found and noting corrective actions taken or planned. If the response is adequate and the complainant satisfied with the response, OSHA generally will not conduct an on-site inspection.

## **PASSAGE OF HIGHWAY EXTENSION KEEPS PROJECTS MOVING FORWARD**

Just hours after the House turned down the Senate's highway funding bill, Congress has passed a \$10.8 billion bill to fund the Highway Trust Fund. Without the temporary patch, the HTF would have run dry this month. The bill is expected to be signed by President Obama and should allow for continued funding for road, highway and bridge construction through May 2015. (See this week's Newsletter page for details). Contractors were notified last month that without action, federally-funding highway and bridge projects would not be funded, effective August 1. FHWA and WVDOH presented contractors with two options: 1/ shut their projects down until funding was made available; or 2/ continue working and be paid 50 cents on the dollar.

Based on Thursday's action, federal projects should continue as normal with no delay in payments expected. "Based on preliminary information, we don't expect a delay in funding for federal projects," FHWA Administrator Tom Smith today told the CAWV. "FHWA had not pulled the trigger on the proposed cash management procedures that were developed so we expect projects to continue as planned." He said he thinks the bill passed by Congress will allow for a transfer of dollars into the Highway Trust fund and he assumes the mechanics of that has been figured out. "That's not to say there won't be a temporary glitch to the infusion of dollars into the trust fund that may delay payments temporarily but it will not be the weeks or months delay that could have occurred," the state administrator stated.

Even with the funding in place and the authorization through May 2014, the CAWV remains committed to addressing the long-term funding solution for the Highway Trust Fund this year, and to working with West Virginia legislators to find solutions to West Virginia's highway funding shortfall.
