WEST VIRGINIA CONSTRUCTION EMPLOYMENT LOSSES CONTINUE TO MOUNT

Construction firms added jobs in 39 states from July 2013 to July 2014 and in 34 states from June to July, according to an analysis of U.S. Labor Department data by the Associated General Contractors of America. West Virginia held the top spot for a number of months for shedding the most construction jobs during the past twelve months but inched up to 49 for the month of April. In the figures released August 18, New Jersey experienced the largest percentage decrease in construction employment in a twelve-month period, ranking it 51 out of 50 states and the District of Columbia. West Virginia is again 50 by losing 2,000 jobs from July 2013 to July 2014, a 5.5 percent reduction. New Jersey saw a 6.5 percent reduction. West Virginia also had the second highest monthly percentage decline from June to July 2014 (-1.8 percent, -600 jobs) ranking it 49. Nebraska had the highest monthly decline. LEGISLATIVE INTERIM MEETINGS TO BE HELD IN BRIDGEPORT

The August Legislative Interim meetings will be held August 25-27 at the Bridgeport Convention Center in Bridgeport. In addition to the regular meetings, lawmakers will tour various locations in North Central West Virginia. The Select Committee on Infrastructure will tour the North Central

West Virginia Airport at Bridgeport, the Committee on Labor will tour Mark West Energy's facility and the Joint Committee on Economic Development will tour the Charles Point/White Oak development, which includes numerous retail shops, hotels and office buildings. A common denominator in these facilities is that they were designed, supplied and constructed by a number of CAWV contractor and associate members. The September interims will be back at the Capitol September 8-10.

CAWV & BRICKSTREET OSHA 10 HOUR COURSE NOW FULL, ADDITIONAL COURSES TO BE SCHEDULED

The second CAWV / BrickStreet Insurance OSHA 10-Hour course for association members that participate in the CAWV / BrickStreet Workers Compensation program has been filled and now has a waiting list. Senate Bill 376 was passed into law during the 2014 legislative session and went effect on July 1, 2014. It requires all construction workers on a publicly financed project over \$50,000 to complete the OSHA 10-Hour Course.

CAWV members also have access to the online training site '[ClickSafety](#)' which offers an OSHA approved 10-Hour training class online for \$80.00. Members can take the class over several days by logging into their account and continuing the class from the point they stopped. Also the CAWV will be adding additional OSHA 10-Hour training courses so students that get left out of this class will be notified and placed into the next class. A few of the provisions of the new law are: The course is a one-time requirement, not annual; For the first year (July 1, 2014 to July 1, 2015) construction workers have to be employed at least 90 days at the public improvement site before they need the course.

The CAWV will be scheduling additional OSHA 10- Hour courses that will be open to all members of the association. CAWV URGES WV SENATORS TO OPPOSE USE OF REVERSE AUCTIONS

The CAWV sent a letter Thursday to Senator Jay Rockefeller and Senator Joe Manchin urging them to file an amendment to S. 2410, the National Defense Authorization Act (NDAA), that would prohibit federal agencies from procuring construction services through reverse auction. “Reverse auctions do not make sense and do not work for construction services, which are project-specific and require expert knowledge,” the CAWV stated. “Each construction project is unique based on its geography – i.e. site conditions, seasonality of construction activities, and project proximity to major suppliers-purpose and requirements – personnel and budget criteria, and specific design and engineering requirements. Reverse auctions do not account for these variables and can lead to greater risk of project default, costing the government and taxpayers. Furthermore, reverse auctions do not guarantee the lowest price for construction services.”

The CAWV also noted the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers – the largest and most experienced federal construction agency – prohibited procurement of construction services through reverse auctions. USACE issued a 2004 report on its construction reverse auction use and determined that such reverse auctions “should be the very rare exception and not the rule – if used at all.” In 2008, USACE testified before the House Small Business Committee and noted that “it found no basis to claim that reverse auctioning provided any significant or marginal savings over a traditional contracting process for construction.” In 2013 before the same committee, USACE stated that “procuring construction by reverse auction neither ensures a fair and reasonable price nor a selection of the most qualified contractors.”

AGC of America noted that despite this knowledge, other federal government construction agencies, like the Departments of Veterans Affairs and the Interior, continue to experiment with reverse auctions for significant construction projects, including large-scale building renovations and park roads. AGC is urging senators to file an amendment to the Senate NDAA bill, S. 2410, that would prohibit federal agencies from procuring construction services through reverse auction. **CAWV members are urged to contact West Virginia’s senators.** See article below on how to use the AGC of America Action Center to contact Sens. TAKE ACTION: BAN REVERSE AUCTIONS FOR CONSTRUCTION

CAWV members are asked to contact Sens. Manchin and Rockefeller to ban federal agencies from procuring construction services through reverse auctions. The Senate is currently considering amendments to its version of the National Defense Authorization Act. The House passed its NDAA bill in May, which included an AGC-supported provision that would help ban federal reverse auctions for construction services.

AGC wants to ensure that the Senate, like the House, hears the construction industry’s voice on reverse auctions. To do so, please take action and contact Sens. Manchin and Rockefeller. NAVIGATING AND ANALYZING FALL HAZARDS

While much advancement has been made in fall protection equipment and technology, falls remain a serious concern in today's work force. Falls are second only to motor vehicle accidents in terms of annual injuries and cost. Whether they occur at the same level (trip and falls, stump and falls, step and falls or slip and falls) or from a higher level, falls typically are very unforgiving. Conducting a thorough job analysis is vital to safe operations when navigating fall hazards and attempting to correctly and safely use fall protection equipment.

FALL HAZARD CAUSES AND ANALYSIS - One of the most important components of conducting a job hazard analysis is observing the operation as it is underway. This helps identify potential hazards and also allows supervisors to evaluate workers' frames of mind. Fall hazards can stem from various situations, including: a foreign object in the walkway, a design flaw in the walking surface, slippery surfaces, an unprotected edge, misuse of fall protection equipment, physical impairments/ailments and falling objects. These and other applicable causes should be taken into account and analyzed. Additionally, these hazards should be sought out during the observation component of the job analysis. Proposed fall protection equipment should be analyzed in order to determine its feasibility and effectiveness.

The accident history of the company and others within the industry also should be analyzed and drawn upon as part of the fall hazard analysis. In addition, the analysis should consider the implementation of existing protocols that can eliminate both foreseen and unforeseen fall hazards. If the analysis identifies a deficiency in an existing fall protection protocol/equipment, the plan should be amended to address all of the fall hazards appropriately.

ADDRESSING UNCONTROLLED FALL HAZARDS - Uncontrolled fall hazards are those that are not, or cannot, be controlled. Most hazards go uncontrolled because they are not identified during the hazard analysis portion of the work plan. Identifying uncontrolled hazards may seem difficult; however, a safety manager who has done his or her due diligence in observing the work in progress and analyzing past accident statistics and other information, as well as analyzing other leading and trailing indicators, stands a good chance of identifying and addressing otherwise uncontrolled or unidentified hazards. Uncontrolled hazards should be eliminated to the maximum extent possible.

ANALYZING IMPACT AND ACCELERATION FACTORS - Impact and acceleration are both very important factors in the identification and analysis of appropriate fall protection plans and equipment. Impact considers the force that will be applied on an employee during the fall arrest process, while the amount of acceleration determines the amount of impact/force that will be placed on the employee. Acceleration and impact are major factors in the speed and force of falling objects that may strike employees working at lower levels. When analyzing impact and acceleration concerns, be sure to consider, identify and mitigate potential causes. The use and effectiveness of personal protective equipment (e.g. hard hats), toe-boards and overhead protection (e.g. canopies) of workers at lower levels also should play a role in impact and acceleration analysis.
