CAWV LEGISLATIVE COMMITTEE PLANS FOR 2015 SESSION

Members of the CAWV Legislative Committee met Wednesday to begin planning for the upcoming session of the West Virginia Legislature. "There is new leadership in the House and Senate which will mean all new committee chairs and possibly new committee staff and counsel," said Chairman C.R. Neighborgall, The Neighborgall Construction Company. "HUB/PAC had a 70 percent success rate in the Senate races we supported and 93 percent rate in House races," the chairman said. "However, with 10 new senators and 33 new delegates elected this term, we will have a lot of new legislators to meet and get to know."

CAWV members will get an email from the committee asking which legislators they know and will be willing to contact when issues arise during the legislative session. Members are also being asked to recommend issues for legislative action, including regulatory or rule revisions. See article below for details.

CAWV NEEDS MEMBER INPUT ON LEGISLATIVE ISSUES

The CAWV's legislative program's successes are a result of the foresight and support of the association's membership. As Legislative Committee Chairman C.R. Neighborgall prepares to formulate a plan for the 2015 legislative session, member input is needed. In this week's Newsletter is a survey asking members to list the top three issues the CAWV should pursue in 2015. **The new House and Senate leadership have asked the CAWV to specifically comment on regulatory issues that affect contracting that, if modified or repealed, would promote a better business climate.** These could be excessive and duplicative environmental issues, litigation, such as Joint and Several Liability, or any other rule or regulation that adds to bureaucracy or unnecessary burdens on a company's operation. SENATE COMMITTEE CHAIRS PREDICTION

Legislators met in Charleston this week for legislative interim meetings. With the historic election Nov. 4 which gave Republicans control of both houses for the first time since the 1930s, the December interims will mainly consist of the transfer of control from outgoing Speaker Tim Miley to Tim Armstead, and Senate President Jeff Kessler to Bill Cole. While the House has not indicated who will serve as committee chairs, *Talkline* host Hoppy Kercheval, in his November 21 commentary, provides a list of possible committee chairs. Committees of importance to the CAWV, and their prospective chairs, are: Majority Leader: Mitch Carmichael; Finance: Mike Hall; Judiciary: Charles Trump; Energy, Industry and Mining: Jeff Mullins; Government Organization: Craig Blair; and Transportation: Chris Walters. Republicans and Democrats will caucus in December to finalize leadership positions.

AGC TO PUSH PENSION PLAN REFORM IN LAME DUCK SESSION

With the midterm election over, AGC of America is once again pushing for Congress to pass multiemployer pension plan reform legislation, largely based off the NCCMP's Retirement Security Review Commission's Solutions Not Bailouts (SNB) proposal. The goal now is to force Congress to deal with this during the lame duck. The breadth of Republican pickups in the election will probably delay action on this legislation next year, so AGC is making a full-court push during the lame duck session.

Congress has several options available to address pension legislation in the remaining weeks of the current session:

- The AGC-preferred action would be enactment of legislation, including the principles in the SNB proposal; however, enactment of SNB is becoming more of an uphill battle, although possible.
- Congress could simply extend the Pension Protection Act (PPA) for another year or two, with a one-year extension being the most likely course of action.
- Congress could fail to act on SNB and allow the PPA to sunset. This scenario is the most unlikely.

AGC continues to advocate for enactment of SNB and highlights the risk of delaying action into another Congress.

U.S. EPA'S LEAD PAINT CERTIFICATIONS UP FOR RENEWAL IN 2015

Contractors who perform work for compensation that disturbs lead-based paint in homes, child-care facilities or schools built before 1978 must be certified by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Lead Renovation, Repair and Painting (LRRP) program. This certification expires every five years. CAWV members who have the certification must submit their re-certification application at least 90 days before their current certification expires. This will help ensure their re-certification is complete before their current expires. In addition to the company's certification, firms must have at least one LRRP "Certified Renovator" assigned to each job where lead-based paint is disturbed. The LRRP Certified Renovator is required to train all non-certified people at the job site in the use of lead-safe work practices. In addition, renovators must complete a renovator refresher course within five years of the date the individual completed the initial course – or the individual must re-take the initial 8-hour course to become certified again.

CHARLESTON CIVIC CENTER DESIGN BUILD RFQS EXTENDED TO DECEMBER 10

Construction firms who are submitting a Request for Qualifications for the \$59 million design build project for the Charleston Civic Center will have until Wednesday, December 10, to submit their qualifications. After the mandatory pre-bid meeting held this week, a few contractors noted

they would like the original December 3 deadline moved. The Civic Center agreed to the extension. All other deadlines outlined in the documents will remain in effect. Only those firms attending the November 19 pre-bid will be allowed to submit on the project. Three firms will be shortlisted to submit a cost proposal. The two unsuccessful firms will be paid a \$100,000 stipend.

COLD WEATHER SAFETY

Summer and fall are gone and the winter months are upon us. Even though it's cold outside we still have to work and get the job done. There are several things we can do to keep warm and prevent cold weather related accidents.

The first thing we want to do is to keep our body temperature at or about normal, 98.6F. This can be accomplished by wearing layers of clothing both inside and outdoors. You should wear cotton or lightweight wool next to the skin and wool layers over your underwear. Keep dry by having proper rain gear available and a pair of good, waterproof boots. An extra pair of clean, dry socks can really come in handy. Don't forget to protect your neck and ears; you can lose a lot of heat from these two areas, and a good pair of gloves is essential.

Do you know the signs of frostbite? Your skin will become white and you won't have much circulation. In the worst case, blisters will form but you won't feel any pain. First aid for frostbite is as follows: NEVER rub the frozen part of the body with snow -- Add extra clothing or use a blanket to cover the frozen area -- get out of the cold and into a warm location -- the frozen area may be immersed in warm water but NEVER use hot water -- if the condition does not improve seek professional medical attention.

Another area of concern during cold weather is the use of portable heaters. If they are not maintained properly they can cause accidents. Carbon monoxide can result from defective ventilating and from incomplete fuel burn. All portable heaters should be checked by a competent person before being put into use. Locate fuel containers, regulators, piping and hose where they will not be subject to damage. LP gas containers not in use should be stored upright, in a specified outside location and protected against damage. Containers in use must be kept in an upright position and secured. Always be sure to protect the valves from physical damage.

Cold weather is here to stay for a few months -- keep your guard up against cold weather injury.

This Route 35 project, which will not have pavement or signage in the contract, is estimated around \$159 million. Based on previous discussions with CAWV members and WVDOH at the Joint Cooperative Committee, the project may be bid as one, any or all of the following:

Project A: WV 869 (Putnam County) to CR 78 Mason County) 7.9 miles
Monthly payments of \$2.1 million for 42 months

Project B: CR 78 (Mason County) to CR 40 (Mason County) 6.7 miles
Monthly payments of \$1.7 million for 42 months

Project AB: WV 869 (Putnam County) to CR 40 (Mason County) 14.6 miles
Monthly payments of \$3.8 million for 42 months

The award will be based on the lowest bid. If the sum of bids on Project A and Project B are lower than the bid on Project AB, the award will be given to the low bidder or bidders if they are two different contractors. The DOH will use a two-step process to select teams. All teams that get a minimum score of 70 will be able to respond to the Request for Proposals (RFP). There will be no stipend or short list on this project. The DOH is expecting to have teams submit their Request for Qualifications (RFQ) around Jan. 16, 2015 with the RFPs being advertised around February 2015. Cost proposals would be due in April. Completion of the project or projects is October 2018.
